The following amendment, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide and Rodenticide (FIFRA), as amended, is acceptable with conditions listed below.

Proposed Amendment:

Label revisions per PR Notice 2007-4 and other minor formatting revisions.

Conditions

Revise the label as follows:

1.) Revise the claim "For Industrial Only" on page 1 to read "For Industrial Use."

2.) Revise the 7th statement under the "Precautionary Statements" on page 3 to read "Wash thoroughly with soap and water after handling and before eating, drinking, smoking tobacco, chewing gum, or using the toilet."

3.) Revise the first statement under Environmental Hazards section on page 3 to be in agreement with the ADBAC RED by adding the statement, "This product is toxic to fish and aquatic invertebrates."

General Comments:

A stamped label acceptable with conditions is enclosed for your records. . Submit three (3) copies of your final printed labeling before distributing or selling the product bearing the revised labeling.

The Cleaner is a heavy-duty detergent complex formulated specifically to remove heavy build-ups and kill odor and rancidity causing microorganisms in the coolant systems of metalworking machines prior to recharging with fresh coolant.

Directions for Use: It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

Always use The Cleaner prior to recharging to avoid contamination of the new coolant and to insure longer coolant life.

1. Pump out or drain the machine thoroughly. Manually remove any chip build-up, slime accumulation and other heavy deposits.

2. Remove all base plates, pump filters and removable weirs to insure accessibility of all hard-to-reach areas.

3. Add The Cleaner to the machine sump at one part The Cleaner to 30 or 40 parts water. (Note: A higher concentration such as 1:10 may be required if severe rancidity or excessive buildup exists.) Circulate solution for at least 10 minutes.

4. While The Cleaner is being circulated in the machine, manually scrub down all machine surfaces, coolant troughs, splash guards, filter areas and tooling mechanisms.5. Pump out The Cleaner solution and thoroughly rinse the coolant system and machine with water at least twice.

6. Charge system with fresh coolant. Repeat cleaning procedure when system becomes excessively dirty.
