DIRECTIONS:

Close room before spraying. Remove protective cap. Holding dispenser upright, point valve in desired direction and press dispensing button to spray. Hold at least 3 feet from all objects or staining may result. Leave room closed and unoccupied 15 to 30 minutes afterward. Sweep up and destroy fallen insects. Do not remain in treated areas. Ventilate areas when treatment is completed.

HOMES AND INDUSTRY: For control of flies, mosquitoes, gnats, flying moths, and certain other flying insects as specified: apply at rate of 4 to 5 seconds per 1000 cubic feet (an average-sized room). Direct aerosol toward all parts of room. For best results direct spray toward corners, under tables, and other such areas where insects may hide. Direct aerosol toward windows and light sources when insects congregate there. Repeat as necessary.

ACTIVE INGREDIENTS: Pyrethrins I & II .500%, *Technical Piperonyl Butoxide 4.600%, Refined Petroleum Oil 8.000%.

INERT INGREDIENTS: 87.500%

*Equivalent to 3.2% (Butylcarbityl) (6-propylpiperonyl) Ether and .8% of Related Compounds.

CAUTION

KEEP OUT OF REACH OF CHILDREN

Do not spray on skin. In case of skin contact, wash with soap and water. Avoid inhalation.

Avoid contamination of food and foodstuffs.

Do not spray on animals. Remove birds, fishbowl, and pets from room being sprayed.

Use as a space spray in food processing plants only when plant is not in operation. Foods should be removed or covered during treatment. All food processing surfaces should be covered or thoroughly cleaned before using.

WARNING: Contains under pressure. Do not puncture. Do not use or store near heat or open flame. Exposure to temperatures above 120° Fahrenheit may cause bursting. Never throw container into fire or incinerator.
