This submission proposes to insert organisms previously accepted but not included on the label to the revised label.

The following amendment submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide and Rodenticide Act (FIFRA), as amended, is acceptable with conditions for some organisms.

Conditions

The proposed label claims that Clorox Toilet Bowl Cleanser is effective against Pseudomanas aeruginosa in toilet bowls is unacceptable and will be removed from the label. These claims supported the registration of this product when it was used as a disinfectant for hard non-porous surfaces in certain settings.


