INSECTS: Aphis Webworm, Aphid, Asparagus Beetle, Bean Beetle, Beet Webworm, Blackberry Maggot, Blister Beetle, Cabbage Worm and Looper, Caterpillar, Cherry Fruit Fly, Colorado Potato Beetle, Cucumber Beetle, Diamond-back Nymph Larva, Exposed Thrips, Flea Beetle, Garden Fleahopper and Webworm, Gooseberry Fruit Worm, Hairybacked Bug, Imported Currant Worm, Japanese Beetle, Leafhopper, Leafminer, Lygus Bug, Milk, Obliquebanded Leafroller, Raspberry Fruit Worm, Red-necked Saw, Rose Chaler, Sod Webworm, Squash Bug (nymph) and Vine Borer, Stink Bug, Strawberry Leafroller and Rootworm, Tortoise Beetle, Vegetable Weevil and Whitefly. For European Corn Borer use 3 to 4 applications or more as eggs start to hatch and repeat at 5-7 day intervals.
