USE AND DIRECTIONS Michco Porcelain Tile Cleaner

For Use in Hospitals, Factories, Schools, Institutions
 For cleaning bathroom tile, and joints, staircases, drinking fountains, porcelain tile, chrome fixtures, wash basins and bath tubs, water closets, swimming pools, shower room walls and floors.

Directions: Lift dispenser nozzle in one hand and apply to area to be cleaned or apply with brush. Allow to remain on surface to penetrate for ten before brushing. Rinse thoroughly with water. Repeat as necessary. Leave 10 minutes to remain in contact with the surface. Rinse thoroughly with water. Repeat as necessary.

Avoid all acid contact with skin and eyes.
 Do not use on pots, or aluminum surfaces.

Danger: Corrosive. Causes eye damage and skin irritation. Do not get in eyes. May be harmful or fatal if swallowed. Protect eyes. Wear rubber gloves when handling. Avoid contamination of food.

First Aid: In case of eye contact, immediately flush eyes with plenty of water for 15 minutes. For eyes get prompt medical attention.

Skin Contact: Wipe off the acid gently, immediately flush with water or soap freely. Rinse with moist magnesia or baking soda.

If Swallowed: Drink promptly large quantity of milk, egg whites, gelatin solution if they are not available, drink large quantities of water. Avoid alcohol. Call a physician immediately.

NOTE TO PHYSICIAN: Probable mucosal damage may contraindicate the use of gastric lavage. Monitor against circulatory shock, respiratory depression and shock. Resuscitation may be needed.

Note: Empty container and rinse thoroughly before disposing. In case of spillage wash with water. Avoid splashing on nylon and cotton.
