

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

Dairies, Beverage, Food Processing Equipment --- Farm Bulk Tanks, Pails, Strainers, Milking Machine Parts.

- A. Clean equipment immediately after use
 1. Rinse with clean water
 2. Wash with recommended Time Chemical product
 3. Rinse with clean water
 4. Air dry—protect from dust and dirt
- B. Sanitize immediately before re-use with Time-Saver Bactericide

Immersion or circulation—use 1 ounce Time-Saver Bactericide per 6 gallons of water (100 ppm available chlorine).

Spray Method — use ¾ oz. Time-Saver Bactericide per 2 gallons of water (250 ppm available chlorine).


