## DIRECTIONS

For most effective results use in a good sprayer. Follow manufacturers recommendations. DO NOT REUSE CONTAINER. DESTROY WHEN EMPTY.

FLYING INSECTS: For control of sand flies, flies, mosquitoes, guits, wasps, hornets and moths direct the spray toward the upper portion of the room filling it with a fog or mist. Use from 1/2 tol ounce per 1000 cubic feet. Spray all floor coverings, walls and sleeping quarters of animals thoroughly.

CRAWLING INSECTS: To control roaches, ants, silverfish, crickets, spiders, carpet beetles, fleas and brown dog ticks, direct a thorough spraying along all walls, floors, floor coverings, shelves, walls, closets, behind baseboards, moldings, cabinet shelves, sinks, doors and window frames and pipes toward drains and dark derners and into cracks, crevices, recessed and similar hiding places, hitting insects disactly wherever possible. For control of carpet beetles spray throughly along baseboards, of carpeting under furniture, under carpeting and rugs in closets and shelving wherever these insects are seen or suspected. In Flea control, be sure that sleeping quarters of animals receive thorough application. Repeated applications may be necessary.

FOR BED BUGS: Be sure that the bed, the springs and the mattress receive thorough spraying, as well as the baseboards, wall cracks about the bedroom, Repeated applications are usually necessary for good results against this pest.

TO CONTROL RED MITES AND BLUE BUGS IN POULTRY HOUSES: First remove dirt and debris, then apply one quart of the insecticide per 1000 sq.ft. of floor space. Spray all surfaces from a distance of approx. 3 to 5 feet. Be sure to wet all surfaces and cracks. NOTE: Insecticide should not be sprayed directly on the fowla.

WEEVILS AND MOTHS INFESTING STORED FOOD PRODUCTS: Clean areas to be sprayed, especially cracks, crevices and around machinery. To spray food storage areas, remove food products from shelves and racks. Spray these areas thoroughly with Mill Spray and replace food products. For packaged food, spray in such a manner that a light mist will fall upon the packages. For food products in sacks, spray thoroughly between and around the sacks, paying particular attention to all cracks, crevices, walls and any other place that might offer shelter to the weevils. After all the local areas of store have been sprayed, close all windows and doors. Thoroughly fog the enitre storage area, being extremely careful that all open food products are covered. After 10 to 20 minutes, sweep up and destroy all fallen insects. Repeat sprayings at least once a week or when reinfestation becomes evident.

CAUTION: KEEP OUT OF REACH OF CHILDREN.

CAUTION: This insecticide is an oil base material and should not be sprayed near or into an open flame. Do not spray more than 1 gallon in 40,000 cubic feet or space to avoid explosion hazards. Harmful if swallowed. Remove, pets, birds and fish bowls before spraying.

When used in food processing plants, foods should be removed or covered during treatment. All food processing surfaces should be covered during treatment or thoroughly cleaned before using. When using the product as a space spray in "these areas, apply only when plant is not in operation."
