FIRST AID

IF IN EYES: Hold eye open and rinse slowly and gently with plenty of water for at least 15 minutes. If wearing contact lens flush for 5 minutes, remove lens and continue to flush. Call a Poison Control Center or Physician for treatment advice.

IF ON SKIN OR CLOTHING: Take off contaminated clothing. Rinse skin immediately with plenty of water for 15 to 20 minutes. Call a Poison Control Center or Physician for treatment advice.

IF SWALLOWED: Call a Poison Control Center or Physician for treatment advice. If able to swallow, sip a glass of water. Do not induce vomiting unless told to do so by the Poison Control Center or Physician. Do not give anything by mouth to an unconscious person.

IF INHALED: Move person to fresh air. If person is not breathing, call 911 or an ambulance, then give artificial respiration, preferably by mouth-to-mouth, if possible. Call a Poison Control Center or Physician for treatment advice.

100 p.p.m. – add 1/6 oz. (4.7 gm.) to each 1 gallon (3.8 L) water.
200 p.p.m. – add 1/3 oz. (9.4 gm.) to each 1 gallon (3.8 L) water.
A level teaspoon in 1 gallon (3.8 L) of water gives 100 p.p.m. av. Cl.
A heaping measure in 3 gallons (11.4 L) of water gives 100 p.p.m. av. Cl.

WISCONSIN FIVE – STEP PROCEDURE

- Scrape and prewash utensils and glasses whenever possible.
- Wash with compatible chemical detergents in hot, warm or cold water ...
T-D-C®, L-f-D®, TAB-DET®, L-f-D-TAB® or BLU-MAGIK®.
Use clean brushes to more effectively remove soil, grease, lipstick, etc.
NEVER USE SOAP.
- Rinse with plain ... potable water. Do Not add any chemicals to this water.
- Sanitize in a **B-T-F®** solution of 1/2 oz. (14.2 gm.) to 3 gal. (11.4 L) water (100 p.p.m.). Immerse all surfaces for contact time specified by governing sanitary code. Check with your Health Department as requirements vary. A two (2) minute exposure is required in some states.
- Place sanitized utensils on rack or drainboard and allow to drain and air dry.

STORAGE and DISPOSAL

STORAGE: Keep container tightly closed when not in use. Store in a cool, dry place. Do not expose to direct sunlight. Do not contaminate water, food or feed by disposal or storage.

DISPOSAL: **WASTES:** resulting from use of this product may be disposed of on site or at an approved waste disposal facility. **CONTAINERS:** Triple Rinse! Then dispose of in a sanitary landfill or by other approved state and local procedures. Do not reuse empty container.
