

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

The contents of this can when used as directed, will make one gallon of finished insecticide, enough to professionally treat the average home. Black Magic Roach Spray Concentrate gives you the kind of control that knocks down and kills Roaches, yet leaves a residual deposit that keeps on killing for weeks.

DIRECTIONS FOR MIXING

Mix entire contents of this can with one gallon of water. Overcap from container may be used as a measuring device for mixing lesser amounts, using 3/4 capful (3 oz.) to each quart of water. Finished spray should not be left to stand overnight. No more solution should be mixed than will be used at one time. Sprayer should be cleaned after each use with water and a small amount of liquid detergent.

DIRECTIONS FOR APPLICATION

Any suitable low pressure sprayer may be used for application. Apply as a coarse spray to areas Roaches and Waterbugs may infest. Thorough application should be made around baseboards, walls, doors and window frames, forcing the insecticide into all cracks. Localized areas of the floor and areas where these insects are seen resting, running or hiding, should be thoroughly treated.
