 - d. Relocate the practical treatment statements so that they appear immediately below the precautionary statements.
 - e. Include the manufacturer's street address on the labeling.
2. Submit the final printed labeling for inclusion in the product file.



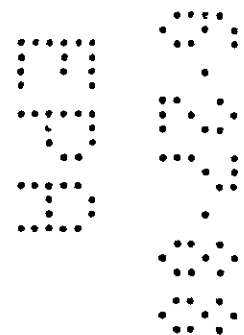

Precautionary Statements

DANGER

Hazards to Humans & Domestic Animals

Keep Out Of Reach Of Children

Highly corrosive. Causes skin and eye damage. ⁶²⁸⁴⁻³⁰ May be fatal if swallowed. Do not get in eyes, on skin or on clothing. ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS

PHYSICAL OR CHEMICAL HAZARDS:

STRONG OXIDIZING AGENT

Mix only into water. Use clean dry utensils. Do not add this product to any dispensing device containing the remains of any other product. Such use may cause a violent reaction leading to fire or explosion. Contamination with moisture, organic matter or other chemicals will start a chemical reaction and generate heat, chlorine gas (and possible fire and explosion). In case of contamination or decomposition, do not reseal container. If possible, isolate container in open air or well ventilated area. Flood with large volumes of water, if necessary.

PRACTICAL TREATMENT (FIRST AID)

IF SWALLOWED: Promptly drink large quantities of water. DO NOT induce vomiting. Get medical attention. Avoid alcohol.

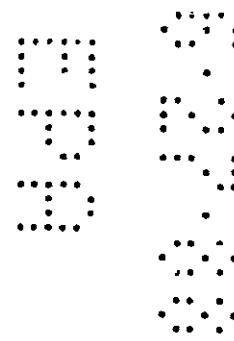
IF ON SKIN: Brush off excess chemical and flush skin with cold water for at least 15 minutes. If irritation persists get medical attention.

IF IN EYES: Flush with cold water for at least 15 minutes. Get medical attention.

IF INHALED: Remove person to fresh air. Get medical attention.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Keep this product dry in a tightly closed container when not in use. Store in a cool, dry, well ventilated area away from heat or open flame. In case of decomposition, isolate container (if possible) and flood area with large amounts of water to dissolve all material before discarding this container. Do not reuse empty container, but place in trash collection. Do not contaminate food or feed by storage, disposal, or cleaning of equipment.



2 'N 1 POOL START

Used once in a new pool or when refilling with fresh water, 2 'N 1 POOL START combines two steps--shocking and stabilizing--eliminates need for two separate chemicals. 2 'N 1 POOL START gives protection against dissipation of chlorine by sunlight and kills algae and bacteria.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

General Classification

It is a violation of federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

1. Clean or backwash filter.
2. Bring pool water pH within a range of 7.2 to 7.6. Add dry acid to reduce pH or soda ash to increase pH as prescribed on labels.
3. Add 2 'N 1 Pool Start slowly through the surface skimmer at the rate of 5 ounces per 1,000 gallons of water.
4. Wait two hours and again adjust pH to 7.2 to 7.6.
5. Test chlorine residual. Do not allow swimmers in pool until chlorine residual has dropped below 3 ppm.
6. Start regular maintenance program with concentrated granular or stabilized concentrated tablets. Follow directions on label.
