

DIRECTIONS

For household cleaning, disinfecting, and deodorizing, mix 2 tablespoonfuls to each gallon of water. Apply so as to wet thoroughly the surfaces being treated. Do not mix with other cleaners. When the surface to be cleaned and disinfected has a heavy soil deposit, this heavy soil should be removed prior to application of Germicidal Cleaner by using NUTRILITE General Purpose Cleaner.
