DIRECTIONS FOR USE

MOTHS

Take special precautions to see that cracks in floors and openings below baseboards are thoroughly wetted with spray liquid. Wool lint and organic matter accumulating in these places will serve as breeding materials for such pests. Clothing to be stored should be cleaned and aired and sprayed carefully from a distance of one to two feet, taking care to see that seams and folds are wetted. Chests in which woollens are to be stored should be thoroughly sprayed before being filled with clothes. Closets should be sprayed liberally at least twice a month, directing the spray on the garments.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

Apply with a regular sprayer giving
a coarse spray for the control of insects
in supermarkets, restaurants, homes, in-
stitutions, food handling establishments,
food processing plants, warehouses, furni-
ture storages and libraries. Will not
mix with water. Caution- Do not spray
near open flame, pilot lights, heating
elements, or other sources of heat.

ROACHES, ANTS, SILVERFISH, WATERBUGS, SPIDERS,
CRICKETS:

Spray directly on insects where possible.
Also spray to wet insect trails and surfaces
wherever insects may breed or congregate
such as under sinks, drainboards, stoves,
refrigerators, in cabinets-around baseboards,
cracks, door sills and frames, window frames,
Ant trails, garbage cans, garages, and out-
buildings. Re-treat as necessary.

FLEAS IN BUILDINGS AND PET QUARTERS:

Spray thoroughly floors, walls, rugs, carpets,
cracks, crevices, sleeping quarters or pets
or other infested areas. Retreat as necessary.

CARPET BEETLES:

Apply to floor areas and baseboards. Spray
directly into cracks, crevices, and under
carpets where insects may be found. Treat
both the underside and topside of infested
carpets. Spray inside of trunks, closets and
infested areas of shelving. Re-treat as
necessary.

BEDBUGS:

Spray thoroughly and repeatedly mattress
and bedding including seams and folds.
Spray bed frames, springs, along baseboards,
carpet edges, cracks and hiding places
about rooms. Apply liberally to side walls
and floors of laundry trucks.

FLEAS AND ANTS OUTDOORS:

Spray to wet localized infestations of these
insects. For ants, thoroughly wet hills and
runways. Retreat floors, baseboards, floor
coverings and wall cracks, as well as sleep-
ing quarters of animals as necessary.

FLIES, MOSQUITOES, GNATS

Close doors and windows directing the spray
upward toward the ceiling. The room should be
filled with mist and remain closed for 10 -
15 minutes. Sweep up dead or stupified
insects and destroy them. Repeat treatment
as often as necessary.
