The amendment referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act, as amended, is acceptable provided that you:

1. Make the labeling changes listed below before you release the product for shipment bearing the amended labeling.
 - a. In the Storage and Disposal section, delete the phrases "buried in a safe place" and "burying in a safe place." Refer to FR Notice 83-3 for acceptable Storage and Disposal statements.
 - b. Delete the word "milk."
 - c. Revise the "First Aid" heading to read "Statement of Practical Treatment."
 - d. The signal word "Danger" must be placed directly below the "Keep Out of Reach of Children" heading (center panel only).
2. Submit five (5) copies of your final printed labeling before you release the product for shipment.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

IT IS A VIOLATION OF FEDERAL LAW TO USE THIS PRODUCT IN A MANNER INCONSISTENT WITH ITS LABELING.
DISINFECTING FLOORS, BATHTUBS, SHOWER STALLS, TOILET SEATS, DIAPER PAILS: Clean surfaces with a solution of 1 fl. oz. of L.O.C.® Regular Liquid Organic Cleaner per gallon of water, rinse, then disinfect by wiping or spraying a solution of 1 fl. oz. PURSUE Germicidal per 3 gallons of water and allow to dry on surface. **Disinfecting Refrigerators, Cupboards, Bread Boxes:** Food must be removed. Clean surfaces thoroughly with L.O.C. Regular (as above). Prepare 1 fl. oz. per 3 gallons solution (as above) and wipe or spray on. Allow to dry on surface. **Disinfecting Sickrooms:** Disinfect hard surfaces (as above). After washing, let dishes and utensils stand for 10 minutes in solution of 1 fl. oz. PURSUE Germicidal per 3 gallons of water. Rinse with potable water. **Disinfecting Laundry:** Add ½ fl. oz. PURSUE Germicidal to final rinse. For front-loading machines, use ¼ fl. oz. (See the PURSUE Brochure SA-3518 for additional use directions.)

SANITIZING DISHES IN COMMERCIAL EATING AND DRINKING ESTABLISHMENTS

Large Utensils, 3 sink system—Hand Washing

1. Scrape food from utensils before washing.
2. Sink No. 1: Use L.O.C. Regular Cleaner (1 fl. oz./gallon) in hot water. For heavily soiled utensils, replace this solution frequently.
3. Sink No. 2: Rinse dishes and utensils in clear, hot water in this sink. Change as often as necessary.
4. Sink No. 3: Use ½ fl. oz. of PURSUE Germicidal Concentrate for each 2 gallons of water; this provides a 200 ppm solution of active ingredient. Dip dishes and utensils for two minutes. Change solution three times daily or whenever the solution becomes soiled.
5. Let dishes and utensils air dry.

Precaution: Do not contaminate food with PURSUE Germicidal Concentrate Solution.

PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS

Avoid alcohol. Call a physician immediately. **NOTE TO PHYSICIAN:** Probable mucosal damage may contraindicate the use of gastric lavage. Measures against circulatory shock, respiratory depression and convulsion may be needed.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

PROHIBITIONS—DO NOT CONTAMINATE WATER, FOOD OR FEED BY STORAGE OR DISPOSAL. OPEN DUMPING IS PROHIBITED. DO NOT REUSE EMPTY CONTAINER.
