DIRECTIONS FOR USE

Remove protective cap. Hold dispenser upright. Point valve toward surface to be sprayed Press the button to release spray.

To repel such insects as mosquitoes, biting flies, sand flies, gnats, chiggers, (or red bugs). ticks, spray on exposed skin and clothing where insects are biting through. Spray from a distance of 6 inches or more, making sure to spray cuffs of trousers, socks and other openings in clothing. Repeat when needed. Will not damage nylon, cotton or wool. Should not be used on rayon and dnyel.

To apply to face, spray a small amount on hand and spread on face avoiding eyes and mouth.

Spray on screens and screen doors as an aid in preventing gnats and other smaller flying insects from entering the premises.
