

PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENT

HAZARDS TO HUMANS & DOMESTIC ANIMALS

CAUTION

Harmful if swallowed, inhaled, or absorbed through the skin, or on clothing. In case of contact, wash immediately with soap and warm water. Wash hands, arms, and face thoroughly with soap and water after handling and before eating or smoking. Wash all contaminated clothing with hot water before re-use. Do not allow spray to contact food, feedstuffs, and water supplies. Thoroughly wash dishes and food handling utensils with soap and water if they become contaminated by application of this product. In hospitals patients should be removed prior to treatment. Room should be ventilated for two hours after spraying. Do not allow children or pets to contact treated surfaces until spray has dried. Remove pets and cover fish bowls (tanks) before spraying.

ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS

This product is toxic to fish, birds, and other wildlife. Keep out of lakes, streams, or ponds. Do not contaminate water by cleaning of equipment or disposal of wastes. Apply this product only as specified on the label.

PHYSICAL OR CHEMICAL HAZARDS

Do not use or store near heat or open flame.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage or disposal. Open dumping is prohibited. STORAGE: If container is damaged: Stop any leaks by repositioning the container or by patching or otherwise repairing the leaks. Take care to avoid contact with pesticide and wear protective gear. On cleanup of spilled liquids, wear protective equipment as required as to prevent contact with the product or its vapors. Cover the spilled areas with generous amounts of absorbent material, such as clay, diatomaceous earth, sand or sawdust. Sweep the contaminated absorbent on to a shovel and put the sweepings into salvage drum. Dispose of wastes as below. Place any leaking container into a similar drum or glass container. Do not store, use, pour or spill near heat or open flame.

PESTICIDE DISPOSAL: Pesticide wastes are toxic. Improper disposal of excess pesticide, spray mixture, or rinsate is a violation of Federal law. A CONCENTRATE-DILUTE BEFORE USING
DILUTING INSTRUCTIONS

Dilute to D.5% SPP-1382 by adding 1 part by weight of the 2.5% concentrate to 4 parts of petroleum distillate.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

For most effective results use in a good sprayer adjusted to deliver a fine mist.

HOUSEFLIES, MOSQUITOES, AND GNATS

Close all doors and windows. Point nozzle upward, direct the spray mist to all parts of the room, especially windows and other light sources which attract these insects. Fill the room with mist, then leave the treated area. Keep the room closed for at least 15 minutes. Ventilate the room when treatment is completed.

WASPS

Application should be made in late evening when insects are at rest. Spray liberally into hiding and breeding places, contacting as many insects as possible. Repeat as necessary.

CRAMMING INSECTS

Roaches, earwigs, grain mites, sowbugs, spiders and centipedes: spray thoroughly into hiding places such as cracks, crevices, moist areas, openings around pipes and sinks, under refrigerators, baseboards, and storage areas. Spray directly on insects where possible.

ANTS

Spray trails, nests and points of entry. Spray on ants where possible. Repeat as necessary.
