

PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS

Hazards to Humans and Domestic Animals

PHYSICAL OR CHEMICAL HAZARD

Extremely llammable, Contents under pressure. Do not use near fire, sparks or flame. Do not puncture or incinerate, Exposure to temperatures above 130 F, may cause hursting.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling

Remove cap and press down button with hole away from you. Hold container approximately 6 inches from animal. Work from rear of animal towards the head, Rulling the hair to permit the spray to penetrate to the skin. Spray only enough to slightly dampen the haw and skin. Wet ticks with the spray. Do not get spray in eyes or on scrotum.

Use spray on the basis of 4 to 6 seconds for a 5 pound cat and 20 to 30 seconds for a 25 pound dog Repeat treatment if necessary; but not more, than once a week. (The hissing sound and the cool sensation caused by the spray may temporarily frighten nervous pets, however, they are expected to become accustomed to the treatment.) Treat bedding, interior of kennels and other places where ticks and fless congregate to help prevent reinfestation.

DISPOSAL

Do not reuse empty container. Wrap container and place in trash collection.
