PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS

Hazards to Humans and Domestic Animals

Caution: Harmful if swallowed, inhaled or absorbed through skin. Avoid contact with skin and eyes. Wash hands with soap and water after using or handling. Do not use on cats or puppies within four weeks of age. Keep out of reach of children.

Notice to Physician: Carbaryl is a moderate reversible cholinesterase inhibitor. Atropine Sulfate is antidote.

PHYSICAL OR CHEMICAL HAZARD

Extremely flammable. Contents under pressure. Do not use near fire, sparks or flame. Do not puncture or incinerate. Exposure to temperatures above 130 °F. may cause bursting.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

Remove cap and press down button with hole away from you. Hold container approximately 6 inches from animal. Work from rear of animal towards the head, fluffing the hair to permit the spray to penetrate to the skin. Spray only enough to slightly dampen the hair and skin. Wet ticks with the spray. Do not get spray in eyes or on scrotum.

Use spray on the basis of 4 to 6 seconds for a 5 pound cat and ³⁰20 to ³⁰30 seconds for a 25 pound dog. Repeat treatment if necessary, but not more than once a week. (The hissing sound and the cool sensation caused by the spray may temporarily frighten nervous pets, however, they are expected to become accustomed to the treatment.) Treat bedding, interior of kennels and other places where ticks and fleas congregate to help prevent reinfestation.

DISPOSAL

Do not reuse empty container. Wrap container and place in trash collection.
