- 1. Make the changes below before releasing the products for shipment bearing the amended labeling:
 - a. For EPA Registration Nos. 7124-23, -49, -52, -57, and -56; add the heading "Precautionary Statements" and the subheading "Hazards to Humans and Domestic Animals." Delete "Corrosive," "Fatal," and the Note to Physician from the Hazards to Humans section.
 - b. Add the statement "May cause skin sensitization in certain individuals" to the Hazards to Humans section.
 - c. Modify Environmental Hazards language as follows:

This pesticide is toxic to fish and aquatic organisms. Do not discharge effluent containing this product into lakes, streams, ponds, estuaries, oceans, or public waters unless this product is specifically identified and addressed in an NPDES permit. Do not discharge effluent containing this product into sewer systems without previously notifying the sewage treatment authority. For guidance contact your State Water Board or Regional office of the EPA.

Submit one (1) copy of final printed labeling incorporating these changes.

A stamped copy of each label is enclosed for your records.

Labeling for EPA Registration Nos. 7124-28 and -39 is not acceptable. Information in our files for products containing quaternary ammonium compounds indicates the correct signal word is "DANGER." Modify precautionary language to include the statement "Causes severe eye and

skin damage." Use environmental hazards language from 1.c. above. Modify ingredient declarations for EPA Registration No. 7124-28 rounding to the nearest "tenth" or "hundredth."
