DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

For the prevention and control of the algae species listed below, pour the desired quantity of Dry Algaecide 90 with water. With the summer empty and the filter on, pour the resulting slurry into the summer or evenly distribute around the edge of the pool.

There is no need to swim after application. Water temperatures of 80°F or greater result in faster algae control. The effectiveness of Dry Algaecide 90 is not influenced by the normal range of pool water pH.

Dry Algaecide 90 is non-foaming, compatible with all pool additives when diluted in pool, will not stain, and is non-corrosive to filters, heaters, piping and fittings. Filtering systems will not reduce the effectiveness of Dry Algaecide 90. The use of Dry Algaecide 90 will not replace the need for chlorine or bromine to maintain proper sanitation, but does relieve the need for excessive quantities of chlorine or bromine to combat algae.

To calculate pool volume of rectangular or square pool, multiply in feet, the length x width x average depth x 7.5; gallons. For a round or oval pool, multiply, in feet, the length x width x average depth x 5.9; gallons.

PREVENTIVE ALGAE TREATMENT

Apply at the rate of 1 1/3 oz. per 10,000 gallons of pool water that is visibly clean. Repeat treatment every 8 to 10 weeks or when algae reappears.

GREEN ALGAE CONTROL

Apply first application at the rate of 2 oz. per 10,000 gallons of pool water when algae growth is first visible. Seven days after treatment, brush algae growth from walls, vacuum out settled algae and immediately begin preventive algae treatment.

BLACK ALGAE CONTROL

Apply first application at the rate of 2 2/3 oz. per 10,000 gallons of pool water when algae growth is first visible. For faster results, remove top of algae growth with wire brush daily and vacuum out settled algae. After seven days, begin preventive algae treatment.

Ounce Dosage

Use ounce scale on side of bottle.

Fractional ounce dosage

Filled inner cap = 1/7 ounce (4 grams)
