1. WHAT IS THIS PACKAGE FOR?

This package of ferti-lome BROAD SPECTRUM WEED KILLER is for control of weeds in lawns, golf courses, and similar tuff areas. See side of container for a partial list of weeds controlled.

2. HOW DO YOU USE IT?

Mix 5 tablespoonfuls in 6 gallons of water. Apply thoroughly to 1000 sq. ft. (10' x 100'). Heavily infested lawns may require repeat application to kill missed weeds. Best results are obtained when weeds are young and actively growing. Application in early Spring and Fall when moisture and temperature make weeds grow rapidly is a good time to spray. Watering and fertilizing schedules should be maintained before and after spraying. Do not apply during periods of drought. If hose end sprayer is used, follow manufacturer's directions for proper mixing. Course sprays are less likely to drift. Do not apply within the dripline of desirable trees and shrubs.

THE THEOLOGICA CONTRACTOR

For use on St. Augustine Grass mix 2 1/2 tablespoonfuls in 12 gals. of water. Apply thoroughly to 2000 sq. ft. of lawn area. Repeat application in 10-14 days if necessary.

Direct spray at undesirable plants. Do not use the same spray equipment for applying other material to plants, as injury will result.

If lawn begins to brown temporarily, water heavily. Do not use on Centipede grass, Dichondra, nor on lawns or turf where desirable Bent-grass or Clovers are present. Do not use on newly seeded lawns or turf.
