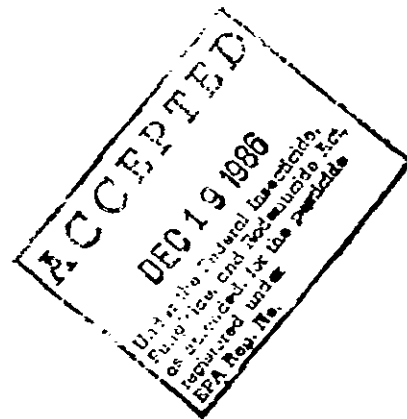

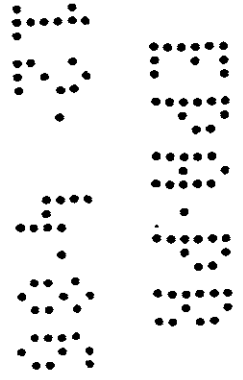

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

Bulbs that are treated with this product must bear distinct labeling that instructs: CAUTION: Treated with thiram. Wear rubber gloves and protective clothing when handling products treated with thiram. Direct exposure to skin may result in severe dermatitis.

American Brand Bulb Dust is a combination of a fungicide & insecticide that can be applied to bulbs to planting or before storage. Contains THIRAM to control storage rot (black rot, root rot, etc.) and METHOXYCHLOR to control thrips and ants. Bulbs, Crows, and Rhizomes include those of Gladiolus, Hyacinth, Iris, Lily, Narcissus and Tulip should be treated as directed.

PRIOR TO PLANTING: Place bulbs in a paper bag with American Brand Bulb Dust. Shake gently to coat the bulbs thoroughly, or place bulbs in a box or basket and dust thoroughly with this product. Plant in properly prepared soil.

PRIOR TO STORAGE: Lift bulbs after foliage has ripened but before skins become brittle and break. Cut off foliage after the outside of the bulbs have dried, wipe off soil and old skins. Treat as directed in paragraph above. Store bulbs in shallow, wire-mesh trays in a draft-free location under proper humidity and temperature conditions for specific bulb type

STORAGE: Store in original container and place in a locked storage area. DISPOSAL: Do not reuse container. Wrap and put in trash.

HAZARDS TO HUMANS & DOMESTIC ANIMALS

CAUTION: Harmful if swallowed, inhaled or absorbed through skin. May irritate eyes, nose, throat & skin. Do not breathe dust. Avoid contact with skin, eyes or clothing. STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT

IF SWALLOWED: Call a physician or Poison Control Center immediately. Drink 1 or 2 glasses of water and induce vomiting by touching back of throat with finger. Never induce vomiting or give anything by mouth to an unconscious person. IF INHALED: Remove victim to fresh air. Apply artificial respiration if indicated. IF ON SKIN: Remove contaminated clothing. Wash affected areas with soap and water. IF IN EYES: Flush eyes with plenty of water. Get medical attention if irritation persists.
