- d. Change the FIRST AID heading to read STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT.
- e. Revise the Storage and Disposal statement to comply with PR Notice 83-3.



If a pseudomonocidal product is needed, then 3 ounces per gallon will be required.

For heavy soil, a precleaning step is recommended before using this product.

For best results, use this with a cloth or mop and apply to walls, floors, and other hard surfaces.
