To Operate: Shake can before using. Hold container upright. Point valve opening away from face and press button.

To Kill House Flies, Mosquitoes, Small Flying Moths, Gnats and Wasps:
Close all doors and windows and direct spray upward into center of room with a slow sweeping motion. Spray 5-10 seconds for average room. Keep room closed for 15 minutes after spraying. Ventilate room thoroughly before re-entry. Sweep up and destroy fallen insects.

To Kill Cockroaches, Ants and Crickets: Contact as many insects as possible with the spray in addition to thorough spraying of all parts of the room suspected of harbouring these pests. Special attention should be paid to cracks, hi-den surfaces under sinks, behind stoves and refrigerators, food storage areas and wherever these pests are suspected of hiding. In the home, all food processing surfaces and utensils should be covered during treatment and thoroughly washed before use. Cover exposed food. To kill ants, treat doors, around window frames, ant trails and other areas of entry. Repeat as necessary.

Precautionary Statements

Hazards to Humans and Domestic Animals

Caution: Harmful if swallowed or abosrbed through skin. Avoid breathing vapors. Avoid contact with skin. In case of contact, immediately flush skin with plenty of water.

Remove pets, birds and cover fish aquariums before spraying.

Statement of Practical Treatment

- IF IN EYES: Flush with plenty of water. Get medical attention.
