- 2. Submit additional pharoah ant efficacy data using 3-4 replicates with 10 queens in each replicate and carpenter ant efficacy data in 20 infested houses, within one year from the date of this registration.
- 3. Submit one year Storage Stability data (830.6317) within 18 months from the date of this registration.
- 4. Make the following changes to the label:
 - a. Revise the EPA Registration Number to read, "EPA Reg. No. 8033-99".
 - b. Delete "other nuisance ants" wherever they appear on the label.
 - c. For acute toxicity category IV, no Precautionary/First Aid statements are required (optional statements) but the "Harmful if swallowed or adsorbed through the skin" and wash after handling" statements (already on the label) are recommended.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

For control of sweet- and grease-eating ants: Acrobat, Argentine, big-headed, carpenter, cornfield, crazy, field, ghost, honey, little black, odorous house, pavement, pharaoh, pyramid, rove, thief, velvety tree, and other nuisance ants.

For indoor and outdoor use.

Place stations by ant trails or close to areas where ants are present in or near structures. Puncture (with pencil or pen tip) pre-cut hole in hinged end of station when ready for use. The hole may be 1/8 to 1/4 inch diameter. Place station so gel bait does not leak out. A second hole for ant access may be made on the unhinged end of the station.

Do not place stations in areas which have been recently sprayed with insecticide or contaminated with foggers, and do not spray insecticide over stations. If you have recently sprayed, remove the dead ants and thoroughly clean the area before placing stations.

Place stations where ants are seen or ant activity is suspected to occur near structures. (For carpenter ant colonies, locate nests and place stations near associated trails.) Place stations next to cracks, crevices, corners and any out of the way place, such as under and behind kitchen appliances, along baseboards, under sinks, in pantry, around pipes and water heater, window and doorframes, and in the garage, attic, or crawl space. Also place adjacent to walls, electrical lines, potted plants, waste receptacles, sensitive electronic equipment, inside drop ceilings and wall voids or anywhere ant problems occur. Do not place stations on food preparation surfaces when food is being handled or on utensils that are used for food preparation.

Likely locations for ants and station placements are areas where ants enter the building structure and areas with potential water damage including: wall voids, cracks and crevices in kitchen, bathroom, under sink, window sills, screen vents, garage, attic, and crawl spaces, eaves, soffits, weep holes, where wires and pipes come into the building structure, and trees, stumps, roots, wood decks, fences, planter boxes, woodpiles, landscaping, and railroad ties near structures. Extreme heat or cold, direct sunlight and water may reduce the residual effectiveness.

Inspect stations as needed. Place new stations in the same area if old stations are empty. Do not refill stations.
