Isopropanol.....	20.50%
Soap Emulsifier.....	5.80%
Sodium-chloro-ortho-phenylphenate.....	4.5%
Pure Steam Distilled Pine Oil.....	10.25%

### INERT INGREDIENTS:

Water.....	58.95%

**DIRECTIONS:** Always dilute with water before using. For maximum efficiency, clean surfaces well before applying disinfectant solution, and make sure solution comes in contact with all infected areas. Use warm water when possible. As a general disinfectant, apply a solution of 1 part Disinfectant to 80 parts water. Let this remain on surfaces as long as possible.

**LOCKER ROOMS, URINALS, TOILETS, SINKS, FLOORS, ETC.:** Clean thoroughly and apply a solution of 2 oz. disinfectant per gallon of water. **AS A DEODORANT SPRAY:** Use 2 oz. Disinfectant to each gallon of water. **AS A GERMICIDAL RINSE:** Use 2-4 oz. per gallon of water. Leave in contact with articles to be disinfected for several minutes.
