  - d. Add the statement "Rinse or wipe lotion from skin before covering skin with clothing" to the Directions for Use.
  - e. Submit a 1-year storage stability study. The product must be tested at room temperature with readings for actives taken at time zero and for 1 year. We suggest that readings be taken every 3 months. This study must be submitted within 15 months of the date of this registration.


