GENERAL INFORMATION: An efficient insecticide has been incorporated, along with a complete plant food formulation, using three different feeding Nitrogens, PLUS the addition of an herbicide. This means one spray application controls Lawn Destroying Insects (such as: cutworms, earwigs, ants lawnmoth) and ugly Broad Leafed Weeds (such as: dandelion, plantain, thistles, morning glory and similar weeds) and develops a HEALTHY, LUSH, GREEN GROWTH. Apply when insects are active and when weeds are growing vigorously.

DIRECTIONS: This product is developed with concentrated materials. Each gallon covers approximately 2000 square feet. We ask you to follow these directions for a more beautiful, healthy and carefree lawn.

1. Water area thoroughly before applying material.
2. Place 3 quarts of water in one gallon spray tank, sprinkling can or other similar containers, add one quart of Lawn Weed & Feed and cover 500 square feet with diluted material. Flush mixing container thoroughly after using.
3. Use normal watering after application is made.
Birds feeding on treated areas may be killed.
