

GENERAL INFORMATION

This product is made specifically for use on valued race horses, fine show animals and by the pleasure riders who want an effective, long lasting fly protection for their animals. It has been formulated to give protection against horse, face, stable, house, horn, and deer flies, mosquitos and gnats. When used as directed, this product will give ample pretection with a single delly application, yet won't burn, blister or discolor the hair. In addition to its repellent qualities, this product contains a highly effective insecticide which kills on contact those few insects which are not repelled from the protected animal.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

Remove the protective cap. Hold container in an upright position 12-18 inches from the animal. With valve opening pointing toward area to be covered, release spray by pressing down on valve.

The most effective over-all application is obtained by first brushing animal to remove loose dirt, dust and debris. Then apply repellent by spraying in a zigzag motion so as to lightly dampen animal's cost. Spray all of animal thoroughly with particular attention to legs and under belly. Grooming animal with a brush following application of repellent will add luster to the animal's cost. Repellent may be applied until hair is moist but do not sook hide. C-V-R-L recommends average of 2 ounces in summer months, 1 ounce in winter months per adult animal per 24 hours, proportionately less for smaller animals. Application during the morning hours (8 to 10 a.m.) will give the greatest protection for the maximum time of repellent effectiveness. Continuous daily treatments give a build-up of repellent effectiveness on the animal and therefore the amount of application may be reduced as control is noted. Face fly protection is best obtained by spraying animal's head and neck using just enough spray in animal's eyes. Repeat application as necessary.

WARNIN

Contents under pressure. Do not puncture. Do not use or store neer heat or open flame. Expesure to temperatures above 130 degrees F bely cause bursting. Never threw container into fire or insteading. Avoid over-application of product which will result by disting animal's hides. Store in seel place, out of direct conflict, and GUT OF REACH OF CHILDREN. Hermful if conflicted.

Continuous daily treatments give a build-up of repellent effectiveness on the animal and therefore the amount of application may be reduced as control is noted. Face fly protection is best obtained by spraying animal's head and neck using just enough spray to slightly dampen the tips of hair. Avoid getting spray in animal's eyes. Repeat application as necessary.
