- e. Incorporate the following statements in the Environmental Hazards section.

Groundwater Advisory: Residues of diclofop-methyl can seep or leach through soil and can contaminate groundwater which may be used as drinking water. Users are advised not to apply diclofop-methyl where the water table (groundwater) is close to the surface and where the soils are very permeable, i.e., well drained soils such as loamy sands. Your local agricultural agencies can provide further information on the type of soil in your area and the location of groundwater.

3. Submit five (5) copies of your final printed labeling before you release the product for shipment. Refer to the A-79 enclosure for a further description of final printed labeling.
