APPLES: For control of Scab, Cedar Rust, Black Rot, Fly Speck, Sooty Blotch, Bitter Rot, Apple Blotch, Botryosphaeria Spot, Aphids, Mites, Leaf Roller, Plum Curculio. Apply 40 lbs. per acre making the first application at Pre-Bloom stage. Repeat at Petal Fall and at 7 to 10 day intervals through the growing season. Keep foliage and fruit covered during infection periods. Do not apply within 14 days of harvest. For the protection of Honey bees, do not apply during bloom period.

CAUTION: Injury to fruit or foliage may result if Parathion is used on McIntosh and related apple varieties.

PEACHES: For control of Fruit Rot, Rhizopus Rot, Scab, Aphid, Mites and Oriental Fruit Moth. Apply 70 lbs. per acre. Make the first application at Petal Fall and repeat cover applications for 3 to 6 times as necessary at 10 to 14 day intervals. Locations in Northeast U.S. - Do not apply within 14 days of harvest. Do not apply more than 5 pounds actual parathion per acre per year.

Antidote - administer atropine sulfate in large doses, TWO to FOUR mg. intravenously or intramuscularly as soon as cyanosis is overcome. Repeat at 5 to 10 minute intervals until signs of atropinization appear. 2-PAM chloride is also antidotal and may be administered in conjunction with atropine. DO NOT GIVE MORPHINE OR TRANQUILIZERS. Parathion is a strong cholinesterase inhibitor affecting the central and peripheral nervous systems and producing cardiac and respiratory depression. At first sign of pulmonary edema, the patient should be given supplemental oxygen and treated symptomatically. Continued absorption of the poison may occur and fatal relapses have been reported after initial improvement: VERY CLOSE SUPERVISION OF THE PATIENT IS INDICATED FOR AT LEAST 48 HOURS.

Consumption of alcoholic beverages increases the toxic effects of Thiram.

ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS

This product is toxic to fish, birds & other wildlife. Birds feeding on treated areas may be killed. Do not contaminate water by cleaning of equipment or disposal of wastes.
