Agway Greenlawn Plus 20-5-7 Crabgrass Killer is a selective pre-emergence crabgrass control for use on new and established lawns, golf courses and other recreational areas. Because of its selectivity, this product may be applied at the time of seeding at recommended rates without causing injury to germinating seed of many common desirable lawn grasses.

The TUPERSAN® weed killer contained in this product is highly effective for the control of Smooth and Hairy Crabgrass, Foxtail and Barnyard grass in newly seeded or established planting of the following turf grasses: bluegrass, fescue, redtop, smooth brome, perennial ryegrass, orchardgrass, and the following strains of bentgrass: Penncross, Seaside, Highland, Astoria, Nimistia, C-1, C-7, and C-19. Do not use on other bentgrass strains, Zoysia, Dichondra or Bermudagrass, as injury to turf may result. Apply on a calm day to avoid wind drift.

NOTE: Use only on turf areas; do not apply to crops used for food or feed purposes. Do not apply this product through any type of irrigation system.

CAUTION: Do not apply on Bermudagrass as injury may result.

The contents of this bag will cover approximately 5,000 sq. ft. To determine the area of a rectangular lawn, multiply its length by its width. If the lawn is irregular in shape, measure several smaller square areas, and add the findings together to determine your total area.

#### HOW AND WHEN TO APPLY TO GET THE BEST RESULTS

#### **NEW LAWN SEEDINGS:**

- 1. Prepare soil and test for pH. Make necessary adjustments to produce a pH reading of 6.5 to 7.0. If you are not able to determine the soil pH, apply 50 pounds of limestone per 1,600 sq. ft., and incorporate into the top 3 inches of soil.
- 2. Seed desirable turf grass mixtures such as Agway Professional Green TM, Royal Green R, Shady Green R, or Wear Green R as directed. For advice on which grass seed mixture is right for

your lawn seeding situation, consult with your local Agway representative.

- 3. Once the grass seed is distributed, lightly rake soil to cover the seed. Firm the seeded area with an empty roller to develop good seed-to-soil contact.
- 4. Apply Greenlawn Plus 20-5-7 Crabgrass Killer at the setting for your spreader listed below. To insure full-season control of crabgrass in newly seeded lawns, make a second application at the same rate four weeks later.
- 5. Mulch the area lightly with either a mulch fabric or quality hay material. This cover will retain water and keep the newly seeded area moist.
- 6. Do not rake the lawn or disturb soil surface after application. Apply water if no rain falls within 3 days after application.
- 7. Water frequently until the new lawn is well established. Successful lawn establishment depends on the new seed being kept moist at all times so it can develop quickly and aggressively.

#### OVERSEEDING ESTABLISHED LAWNS

- 1. Mow lawn closely.
- 2. Rake established lawn vigorously with a rigid metal or thatching rake to create grooves in the soil surface.
- 3. Seed desirable turf grass mixture per seed directions.
- 4. Apply Greenlawn Plus 20-5-7 Crabgrass Killer at the OVERSEEDING setting for your spreader listed below before forsythia is in full bloom.
- 5. Firm the seeded area with an empty roller to develop good seed-to-soil contact.
- 6. Water immediately to settle fertilizer into the soil.
- 7. Do not rake the lawn or disturb soil surface after application. Apply water if no rain falls within 3 days after application.
- 8. Water frequently until the new seed has germinated and is well established. Successful establishment of the overseeded area depends on the new seed being kept moist at all times so it can develop quickly and aggressively.

# WHAT DO I USE TO FERTILIZER A NEWLY GERMINATED LAWN?

Agway Greenlawn Plus 20-5-7 Crabgrass Killer may be applied to newly germinated securings from which new grass has emerged.

- 1. Apply when new turf blades are dry (most likely late afternoon).
- 2. Apply Greenlawn Plus 20-5-7 Crabgrass Killer at the setting for your spreader listed below.

- 3. Water immediately after application to settle fertilizer into roots of new growth. Do not make application within one month of previous application of Agway Greenlawn Plus 20-5-7 Crabgrass Killer.
- 4. After four mowings of new lawn area, apply Agway Greenlawn Plus 20-5-7 Crabgrass Killer per label directions.

#### **SPREADING NOTES**

Set your fertilizer spreader according to the chart below. Do not re-enter or permit others to reenter treated areas until fertilizer has settled on lawn.

## For Drop-type Spreaders

Mow lawn to a height of 2-1/2 to 3 inches--short enough so that grass will not touch the bottom of spreader. Walk spreader the length of the lawn. Move control lever of spreader to the open position as you begin walking the spreader over the lawn. As you reach the end of each pass, move the control lever to the closed position; overlap wheel marks to ensure uniform application and results.


### **Rotary Spreaders**

Overlap applications at least 1 foot to avoid skips; as you reach the end of each pass, move the control lever to the closed position to ensure consistent results.
