DO apply when temperatures are rising and foliage is dry; thoroughly cover top and bottom of leaves, and all soft tissues; and apply several light sprayings rather than a single heavy one.

DO NOT combine with other materials; have the foliage wet with spray materials at the end of the day; freeze; or store the mixed solution.

SPRING - For most effective protection, start using J&P Mildew King early in the spring when the first leaf buds start to develop. Spray weekly for the first month, then every 10 days. SUMMER - When temperatures exceed 80° every afternoon, there is usually little necessity for spraying. When temperatures are below 80°, spray every 10 days.

FALL - Spray weekly in the cooler fall weather.

GREENHOUSE - Use according to directions for outdoor spraying.

### SPECIAL INSTRUCTIONS

Always spray plants within 24 hours after any rain.

DORMANT SPRAYING - Use a dilution of 1 to 200. Do not apply under adverse drying conditions (when weather is damp or wet, preventing sprayed areas from drying).

SEVERE MILDEW – Use a dilution of 1 to 400 to bring the infection under control. Do not spray unusually soft or tender growth, nor at temperatures above 75°. Do not apply under adverse drying conditions. Resume spraying at a 1 to 600 dilution for subsequent applications.
