The application referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act, as amended, is acceptable, and a copy of a stamped label is enclosed for your records.

Please make the following revisions when preparing the actual finished label:

- 1. Replace the ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS section with "This pesticide is highly toxic top birds, fish, and other wildlife. Birds feeding or drinking on treated area may be killed. Keep out of lakes, streams, ponds, tidal marshes, and estuaries. Do not apply directly. Do not contaminate water by disposal.
- 2. Replace STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT with "If swallowed: Call a physician immediately. DO NOT INDUCE VOMITING UNLESS NO OTHER TREATMENT IS AVAILABLE. Vomiting may cause aspiration pneumonia. If it is necessary to induce vomiting, give victim one or two glasses of water and insert finger in back of throat. Do not induce vomiting or give anything by mouth if person is unconscious or convulsing. If inhaled: Remove victim to fresh air and apply artificial respiration if indicated. Get medical attention if irritation persists. If on skin: Wash promptly with soap and water. Get medical attention.

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- 3. Under DIRECTIONS FOR USE change "Federal Law" to "Federal law".
- 4. Replace NOTE with "1) Do not use this product indoors as an overall surface spray or as a space spray: take care not to introduce this product into the air during application. 2) Use only in well ventilated areas. 3) Do not apply where children are likely to frequently contact treated surfaces. 4) Remove or cover fish bowls and remove pets before application. 5) Do not treat pets or plants with this product. 6) Do not allow children or pets in treated areas until spray has dried. 7) If clothing is sprayed during application, remove clothing immediately after spraying and launder before wearing again. 8) Do not apply directly to carpets or floor coverings and avoid excessive wetting on asphalt tile, rubber and plastic materials because damage may occur. 9) Care should be taken to avoid spotting of walls, wall coverings, and fabrics. 10) Do not apply directly to upholstery or furniture. 11) Do not apply to areas, surfaces, or utensils which will contact food or feed. 12) Exposed food surfaces should be covered or removed during application. 13) All food processing surfaces and utensils should be covered during application and thoroughly washed with soap and water before use. 14) Do not use in conduits, motor housings or electrical switch boxes.".

Your Confidential Statement of Formula (CSF) does not list the impurities of toxicological concern separately nor does it include the diazinon certification for FIFRA Sec. 12(a)(1)(C), that the description of this product refers to the composition set forth on the CSF and supporting materials as required by the Diazinon Registration Standard. Please check with your supplier in this regard and update your CSF accordingly.

#### DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling. For spot application only. Do not use as a space spray.

Remove protective cap. Hold dispenser upright, point valve opening away from face, and about 8-10 inches from surface being treated. Aim nozzle, press plastic button to release spray. Apply spray covering 1 to 2 linear feet per second to infested cracks, crevices, baseboards and areas where the insects rest and hide. Moisten surface thoroughly, avoid running or streaking. Spray leaves an invisible film, that kills many insects crawling over it.

### NOTE

Do not use this product indoors as an overall surface spray or as a space spray. Take care not to introduce this product into the air during application. Use only in well ventilated areas. Do not apply where children are likely to frequently co tact treated surfaces. Do not treat pets or plants with this product. Remove pet and cover fish bowls before spraying. Do not apply when other persons are in the immediate area. Do not allow children or pets in treated areas until spray has dried. Do not use in commercial food processing, preparation, serving or storage areas. In the home, all food processing surfaces and utensils should be covered during treatment or thoroughly washed before use. Cover or remove exposed food.

TO KILL ROACHES, WATERBUGS, SPIDERS, CRICKETS, SILVERFISH and certain other crawling insects - spray infested areas around refrigerators, under sinks, behind shelving, book cases and other hiding places; particularly infested cracks, crevices and baseboards. Repeat as necessary. Do not spray inside cabinets where food is stored. Discard infested food packages. Do not spray across top of stove or near pilot lights.
