The Agency, in accordance with the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide and Rodenticide Act (FIFRA), as amended, has completed reviewing all of the information submitted with your application to support the reregistration of the above referenced product in connection with the MGK-264 RED, and has concluded that your submission is acceptable.

NOTE: This product is **not** being reregistered under sections 3(c)5 and 4(g) of FIFRA at this time.

Please be reminded that 40 CFR Part 156.140(a)(4) requires that a batch code, lot number, or other code identifying the batch of the pesticide distributed and sold be placed on non-refillable containers. The code may appear either on the label or durably marked on the container itself, and can be added by non-notification per PRN 98-10.

Please note that the record for this product currently contains the Confidential Statements of Formulation (CSFs) listed below. Any previously dated CSFs are superseded.

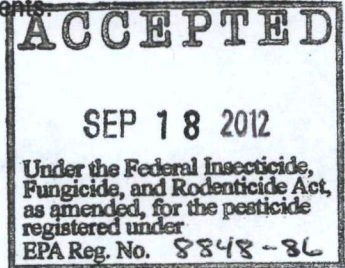

PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS

Hazards to Humans and Domestic Animals

CAUTION: Harmful if absorbed through skin. Causes moderate eye irritation. Avoid contact with skin, eyes or clothing. Remove and wash contaminated clothing before reuse. Wear long-sleeved shirt, long pants, socks, shoes and chemical-resistant gloves (Barrier laminate, nitrile rubber, neoprene rubber, Viton, EPA selection category E. Thoroughly wash with soap and water after handling and before eating, drinking, chewing gum, using tobacco or using the toilet.

Environmental Hazards

This pesticide is toxic to fish and aquatic invertebrates. Do not apply directly to or near water. Drift and run-off may be hazardous to aquatic life in water adjacent to treated areas. Do not contaminate water when disposing of equipment, washwater or rinsate. See Directions for Use for additional precautions and requirements.

Physical or Chemical Hazards

Flammable: Keep away from heat, sparks and open flame. Do not use under or around gas stoves, water heaters or other gas utilities (including home heating units) with open flames or pilot lights. Contents under pressure. Do not puncture or incinerate container. Exposure to temperatures above 130°F may cause bursting. Do not use this product in or on electrical equipment due to the possibility of shock hazard.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

Restrictions and Precautions

Do not use in commercial food processing, preparation, or food storage/serving areas. Remove or cover exposed food and drinking water before application. Remove or cover dishes, utensils, food processing equipment and food preparation surfaces, or wash them before use. Do not allow adults, children or pets to enter the treated area until sprays have dried. Do not apply this product in a way that will contact adults, children or pets, either directly or through drift. Remove pets/birds and cover fish aquariums before spraying. Do not apply to classrooms when in use. Do not apply in occupied patient rooms or in any rooms/areas while occupied by patients, the elderly or infirm. Do not apply to institutions (including libraries, sports facilities, etc.) in the immediate area when occupants are present. Do not apply directly to sewers or drains or to any area like a gutter where drainage to sewers, storm drains, water bodies or aquatic habitat can occur. Do not allow the product to enter any drain during or after application.

Shake Well Before Use

Use this spray as a spot or crack and crevice treatment to control cockroaches, fleas, silverfish, ticks, waterbugs and other insects listed below. Apply this product only as a coarse spray or crack and crevice treatment to localized areas where pests are found or may occur. Spray surface until wet but not to the point of run-off.

For Spot Treatment

To Kill Ants, Carpet Beetles, Cockroaches, Crickets, Silverfish, Sowbugs and Spiders: Spray areas where these insects are found or may hide, including dark corners of rooms and closets; cracks and crevices in walls; along baseboards and door/window frames; behind and beneath sinks, stoves, refrigerators and cabinets; and around garbage cans, plumbing and other utility installations. Directly spray pests driven out of hiding places. For ants, apply to ant trails, around doors and windows and wherever else these pests may find entrance.

To Kill Brown Dog Ticks and Fleas: Thoroughly apply as spot treatment to infested areas such as pet beds and resting quarters; nearby cracks and crevices; along and behind baseboards, window/door frames and localized areas of floor and floor coverings where these pests may be present. Remove and replace old bedding with clean, fresh bedding after treatment. **Do Not Spray Pets with this Product.** To control the source of flea infestations, treat your pet with a product registered for use on animals; also treat your yard with a product registered for yard application.

For Crack and Crevice

To Kill Ants, Brown Dog Ticks, Carpet Beetles, Cockroaches, Crickets, Fleas, Silverfish, Sowbugs and Spiders: Apply spray in small amounts directly into cracks and crevices; in points between different elements of construction; between equipment, floors and openings leading to voids; into hollow spaces in walls; and on equipment legs and bases where the above listed insects hide. Take care to avoid depositing the product onto exposed surfaces or introducing the material into the air.

Storage and Disposal

Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage or disposal.

Pesticide Storage: Store in a cool, dry (preferably locked) area away from food and pet food. **Pesticide Disposal and Container Handling:** Do not puncture or incinerate! **If empty:** Place in trash or offer for recycling if available.
