Dear Ms. Walters,

The label referred to above, submitted in connection with the registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act (FIFRA), as amended, is acceptable, provided you incorporate the Agency's conditions as enumerated in this letter below and submit one copy of your final printed label prior to releasing the product for shipment.

- 1) The added note found on page 1 and 2 of the label, "(note: weight will vary per end use product, but will not be less than 25 lbs.)", must be removed from the label. All container sizes must be specified on the EPA Form 8570-1 (Section III, Box #4).
- 2) The header "Statement of Practical Treatement" must be changed to "First Aid".
- 3) Under the "Suggested Spreader Settings" the registrant must include on the revised product label the list or table of suggested spreader settings.

Submit one copy of the revised final printed label before releasing the product for shipment. If the conditions enumerated above are not complied with, the registration will be subject to cancellation in accordance with FIFRA Section 6(e).

Not for use on turf grown for sale or other commercial use as sod or for commercial seed production or for research purposes.

SURFACE INSECT CONTROL

Apply at the rate of 3.3-4.4 lbs. per 1000 square feet, or the equivalent of 0.75-1.0 lbs. actual active ingredient per acre. At this rate, the product will control chinch bugs, sod webworms (lawn moths), ants, billbugs, brown dog ticks, crickets, cutworms, earwigs, grasshoppers, armyworms, centipedes, clover mites, fiery skipper, fleas, greenbugs, June beetles, leafhoppers, millipedes, mites, mosquitoes, sowbugs and ticks.

Treat when insects first appear, re-treat as necessary. For best results, product should be watered in after application.

GRUB CONTROL

Apply at the rate of 3.3 - 4.4 lbs. per 1000 square feet, or the equivalent of 0.75 - 1.0 lbs. actual active ingredient per acre. At this rate, the product will control certain white grubs (larvae of European chaffer and Japanese beetle).

Treat when grubs are young and actively feeding near the soil surface. Consult your local agricultural extension service for proper time to treat in your area. For best results, product should be thoroughly watered in to wash the insecticide into the zone of insect infestation.

To control Hyperodes (turfgrass) weevils, uniformly apply 4.4 pounds of granules per 1,000 sq. ft. as directed above. Treat suspected problem areas in mid-April and again in mid-May. Consult your local Agricultural Extension Service specialists for best time to treat in your area.

Maximum application rate is 1 lb. ai per acre (4.4 pounds of product per 1,000 square feet).

SUGGESTED SPREADER SETTINGS
