TWIN LIGHT GRANULAR LAWN INSECTICIDE WITH DURSBAN

Dear Registrant:

The labeling cited above and submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act, as amended, successfully REMOVES THE PRODUCT FROM THE SCOPE of PR Notice 93-7 once the comments (if any) on the attached sheet are addressed. Other than the alterations (if any) listed on the attached sheet, no further alterations to the labeling are necessary to reflect the requirements of the Worker Protection Standard.

Since your amendment proposes to delete uses directly and/or to delete uses implicitly through the use of exclusionary statements, the Agency will publish in the Federal Register a notice of receipt of your amendment to delete uses, as required by section 6(f)(1) of FIFRA. The Agency will deter action for 90 days from the date of the Federal Register notice to give affected minor users an opportunity to try to persuade you to retain the uses(s). When the comment period has expired, the Agency will approve the amendment unless you have withdrawn it, and stamp the amended labeling "accepted." Your stamped-accepted labeling will then be sent to you.

As described in Supplement A of PR Notice 93-11 (self-verification option), you may sell and distribute product bearing the submitted labeling before you receive a copy of your stamped-accepted labeling. Note that your registration is not amended until the comment period required by section 6(f)(1) of FIFRA has expired and the Agency has approved the amendment. Therefore, you may withdraw your proposed amendment at any time during the comment period and until you receive your stamped-accepted labeling.

ORNAMENTAL TURF

(Do not use on Dichondra)

CHINCH BUGS; SOD WEBWORMS, ANTS, EARWIGS, CRICKETS, CUTWORMS, BROWN DOG TICKS and SOWBUGS (PILLBUGS).

Spread uniformly at a rate of 2 pounds per 1,000 sq. ft. In northeastern states, make first application in May or June or when insects first appear. Retreat as needed, usually in July or Augusc

Consult your Extension Service Specialist as to exact timing of applications.

(Wash granules into soil with 30 gallons of water per 1,000 sq. ft.)

HYPERODES WEEVIL:

Apply uniformly at a rate of 4 pounds per 1,000 sq. ft. Make the first application of suspected area in mad-April followed by second application 30 days later.

To help obtain uniform distribution, apply one-half the required amount of product in one direction, then apply the balance at a right angle.

After application sprinkle the lawn thoroughly to wash the insecticide off the grass and on to the turf.

(Wash granules into soil with 30 gallons of water per 1,000 sq. ft.)

JAPANESE BEETLE GRUBS and EUROPEAN CHAFER GRUBS:

Apply uniformly at a rate of 4 to 8 pounds per 1,000 sq. ft.

For Grub control, apply anytime between July and early October when grubs are young and feeding near soil surface.

NOTE: For Hyperodes weevil and grubs make application using the above spreader settings in criss cross fashion.

After application sprinkle the lawn thoroughly to wash the insecticide off the grass and on to the turf.

(Wash granules into soil with 30 gallons of water per 1,000 sq. ft.)

Consult your Extension Service Specialist as to exact timing of applications.

SUGGESTED SPREADER SETTINGS

(available at final printing)

Important: These settings are only approximate. Age and condition of spreader can cause wide variation. Be sure to calibrate your spreader with each application.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

FOR HOMEOWNER USE ONLY:

Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage and disposal. Keep container closed and away form food, feedstuffs and domestic water supplies.
