Directions for use

Mixing Instructions

Add ProTurf Andersons Golf Products Fluid Fungicide II to the spray tank during filling, while maintaining some agitation.

Thoroughly rinse container and pour remaining contents into spray tank.

Do not combine ProTurf Fluid Fungicide II in the spray tank with surfactants or other adjuvants.

Application directions

Apply with standard pressurized spray equipment. Works well with normal spray heads.

Use the rates recommended with 4-7 gallons of water per 1,000 sq. ft. to achieve satisfactory coverage.

To Prevent Disease – Use the NORMAL RATE when weather conditions are favorable for the development of disease. Repeat on a 10 day schedule for Pythium and 7-10 days for brown patch and dollar spot control.

To control Moderate to Severe Disease Infestations, use the DOUBLE RATE. Repeat on a 7-14 day schedule until disease is brought under control, then treat at the NORMAL RATE on a preventative schedule.

For Newly Seeded Areas –

Use the NORMAL RATE immediately after seeding. Irrigate with ¼ inch of water. Repeat at 5-7 day intervals if conditions remain favorable for disease. Under severe disease conditions, apply the DOUBLE RATE and repeat in 10-14 days.
