DIRECTIONS

It is a violation of federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

SUR-CAL CHLORINATING GRANULAR is a concentrated chlorine flowing form. SUR-CAL controls growth of algae and many bacteria thus helps keep your pool or spa in a sanitary condition. Measure 1 cup or scoops to measure.

INITIAL CHLORINATION Adjust pH to 7.2-7.6. Add 1 lb SUR-CAL GRANULAR for each 1000 gal of spa water and then test the chlorine level with a pool test kit. If below 1.0 ppm (dosage until 1.0 ppm is reached for spas). Pool should not be used until chlorine residual reads 1.0 ppm.

ROUTINE CHLORINATION SUBSEQUENTLY ADD 1 lb SUR-CAL GRAN. per 5,000 gal (500 gal of spa water) or 1 lb to maintain 1.0 ppm (whether the pool is in use or not). Test frequently to determine if any chlorine residual is present. If possible to increase residual by 1.0 ppm by adding 1 lb SUR-CAL GRANULAR for each 5,000 gal of water to the pool water. Do not add material directly to the pool.
