CB Fogger V
EPA Reg. No. 9444-101
Submissions: Sept. 1 & 27, 1988 and Nov. 22, 1989

The labeling referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act, as amended, is acceptable subject to the comments listed below. Five copies of the finished labeling must be submitted prior to releasing the product for shipment.

- 1) Add as a sub-statement to the ingredient statement "Contains Petroleum Distillate".
- 2) Add an appropriate statement of Practical Treatment. You may consider a statement similar to the following:

STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT

IF SWALLOWED: Call a physician or Poison Control Center immediately. Do not induce vomiting because of aspiration of pneumonia hazard.

IF IN EYES: Flush with plenty of water. Get medical attention if irritation persists.


IF ON SKIN
OR CLOTHING: Remove contaminated clothing and wash before reuse. Wash skin with soap and warm water. Get medical attention if irritation persists.

IF INHALED: Remove victim to fresh air. Apply artificial respiration if indicated.

- 3) Remove from the ingredient statement "related compounds" and change percentage for d-trans Allethrin to "0.323%".

It is understood that methylene chloride is no longer used as a solvent in this formulation. Such use would be inconsistent with the terms of registration.

Do not use in commercial food processing, preparation, serving or storage areas. In the home, all food processing surfaces and utensils should be covered during treatment or thoroughly washed before use. Cover exposed food.

Remove pets, birds and cover fish aquariums before spraying.

Directions for Use

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

Storage and Disposal

Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage or disposal.
Storage: Store in a cool, dry area away from heat or open flame.

Disposal: Do not re-use empty container. Wrap container and put in trash collection.

This product will kill Cockroaches, Houseflies, Black Carpet Beetles, Saw-toothed Grain Beetles, Rice Weevils, Small Flying Moths, Fleas, Ticks, Pill Bugs, Crickets.

Cover exposed food, dishes and food-handling equipment. Open cabinets and doors to area to be treated. Shut off fans and air conditioners. Put out all flames and pilot lights. Close doors and windows. Point valve opening away from face and eyes when releasing. Use one unit for each 6,000 cubic feet of unobstructed area. Use additional units for remote rooms or where free flow of mist is not assured. Do not remain in the area during treatment and ventilate thoroughly before re-entry.

TO OPERATE VALVE: To lock valve in open position for automatic discharge, press valve button all the way down, hooking the catch. Then place fogger on stand or table in the center of the room with valve locked open, placing several layers of newspaper or pad under fogger. Leave building at once and keep building closed for four hours before airing out. Open all doors and windows and allow to air for 30 minutes. Repeat spraying in two weeks or when necessary.

To Kill Ticks and Fleas: Destroy old pet bedding and replace. Use product as above. Treat dogs and cats with registered tick control product prior to re-entry.
