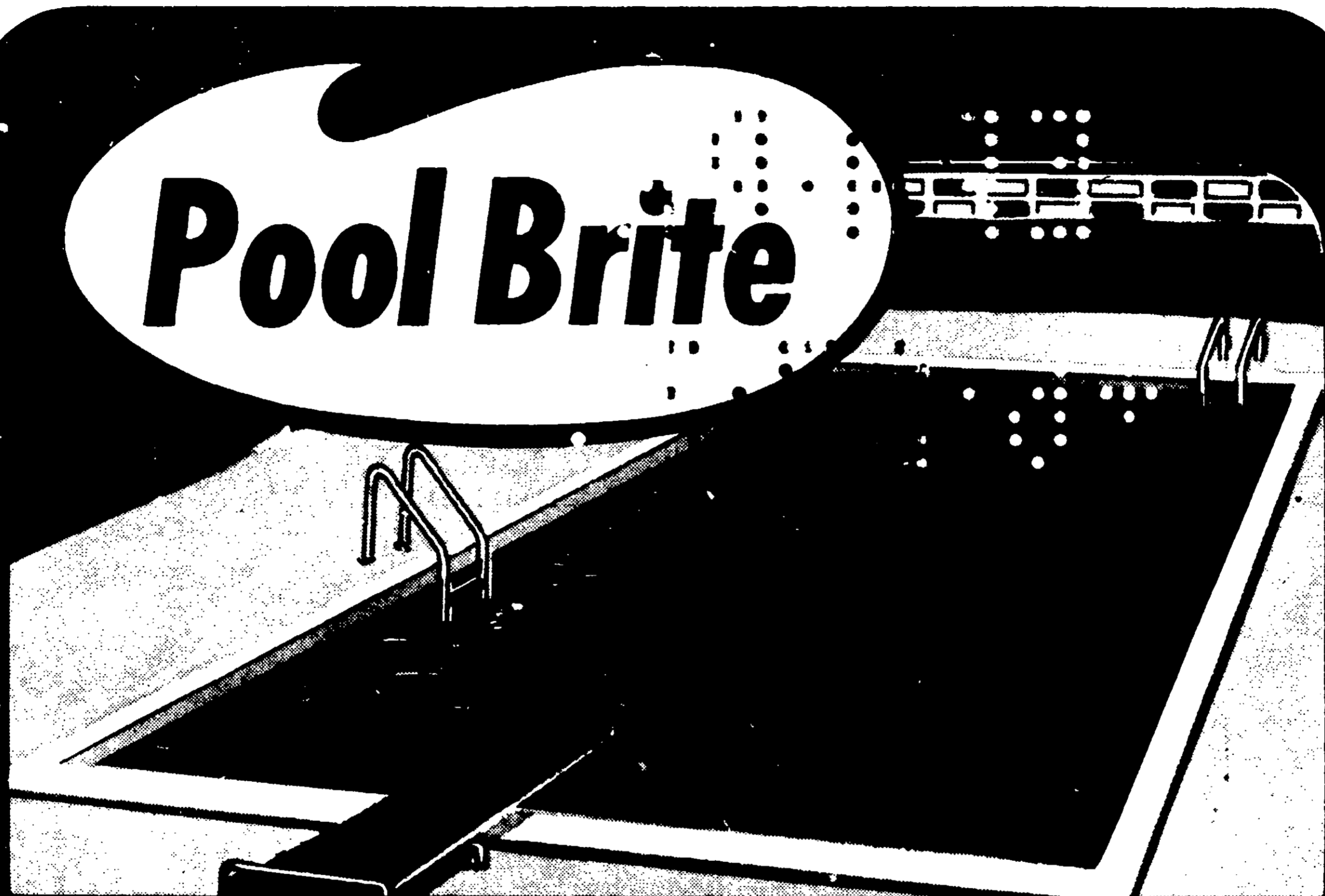

The purpose of Algae Pool Shock is to provide urgent and immediate treatment of pool water when the following conditions exist:

- Green colored water due to algae growth
- Visible algae clinging to floor & sides
- Water with cloudy conditions
- Freshly filled pools that are green or brown due to minerals.
- Treatment of previous season's water
- Periodic shock treatment as regular maintenance

## DIRECTIONS

1. Remove any foreign debris in the water.
2. Adjust pH of water to 7.2 & 7.8 with the use of a test kit.
3. With filter running, sprinkle Algae Pool Shock in the deepest part of the pool at the rate of 1 lb. for each 8,000 gallons of water which will provide 10 ppm chlorine. It is possible for some of the granules to reach the bottom of the pool before completely dissolved, it is then recommended that the floor of the pool be brushed for at least 10 to 15 minutes to prevent possible bleaching of the liner or painted surface. As an occasional shock treat, Algae Pool Shock could be applied through the skimmer, but is not recommended as a regular maintenance application.
4. Allow filter to run continuously and watch for build-up of dead algae in filter which will require repeated backwashing. If your condition is not corrected during the first 24 hours, repeat dosage on second day. If there is not improvement on the third day, consult your dealer for additional advice. Resume regular chlorine dosage when chlorine residual reads 1 & 2 ppm on your test kit.
