TREATMENT

IF SWALLOWED Call a physician immediately. Gastric lavage is indicated if material was taken internally. DO NOT INDUCE VOMITING unless other treatment is not available. Vomiting may cause aspiration pneumonia. If it is necessary to induce vomiting, give victim one or two glasses of water and insert finger in back of throat. Repeat until vomit fluid is clear. Do not induce vomiting or give anything by mouth to an unconscious person.

IF INHALED Remove victim to fresh air and apply respiration if indicated.

IF ON SKIN Wash promptly with soap and water. Rinse thoroughly.

IF IN EYES Rinse eyes for at least 15 minutes with water and call physician immediately.

SUBTERRANEAN TERMITES— DIRECTIONS FOR NON- PROFESSIONAL USE.

This is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

Basement or crawl space construction:—
First remove all loose debris and loose soils. Around piers, posts, chimney
stacks and along foundations of paved concrete dig a trench 6 inches wide
and 4 inches deep. For brick and block foundations dig the trench about 12
inches deep. If footing is more than 12 inches deep, make holes with a
shovel just or just apart that extend from the trench below to
the footing. Make holes closer on hard packed clay soils. Never dig below the
top of the footing. Apply the solution to the soil at a rate of 6 gallons per 10
square feet per foot of depth. Apply half at this to the back, 60 degrees, trail
along the inside of foundations of crawl space buildings. Cover treated soil
with a thin layer of untreated soil. And take care to avoid contaminating water
supplies.

For raised porches, terraces, and entrance slabs, drill holes at one foot
intervals, 6 inches from the foundation and pour one-half gallon of solution
into each hole. Drill holes. Slabs with heat ducts or radiating heat pipes
should be treated by professional pest control operators.
The object is to establish a treated soil barrier which will prevent termite entry.
Other critical areas may also require treatment, particularly if there are
inaccessible areas, stumps or slab-type construction. It is suggested that you contact the Agricultural Cooperative Extension Service for advice or contact
a Professional Pest Control Service.

Block-on-ground-construction:

(Preconstruction application)
(a) Apply an even coat treated under entire surface of floor slab including
porch floors and entrance platforms. Apply at a rate of 3 gallons per 10 square
feet, except that if the under slab is gravel or other coarse aggregate material
apply at a rate of 2 gallons per 7 square feet.
(b) Apply to critical areas along both sides of foundation wall at a rate of 1
gallon per 2½ linear feet per foot of depth.
(c) Treat all above-ground foundation walls. Apply to walls at a rate of 1 gallon per
3 square feet. The objective is to establish a treated soil barrier which will
prevent termite entry.
Food contamination of public and private water supplies by following these
procedures. Use arts back flow irrigation equipment. Refer to Federal
Dental Housing Administration state and local specifications for safe
distances of treatment away from wells. Soil in the vicinity of wells should not
be treated if it is water saturated or by injecting the solution under pressure.
Soil should be removed to an area safe 1 foot well contamination treated, and
returned to the area which has been lined with plastic sheeting.

MIXING DIRECTIONS

For use with Spraying Gun or Pressure Type Garden Sprayer. Thoroughly mix 1
part of concentrate with 10 parts water (1/2 tablespoon per gallon for 1%
concentration recommended treatment).

45% Concentrate	For 1% Solution Mix with water to make gallons listed below.
1 gallon	60'
1/2 gallon	25

Do not apply when ground is frozen.

The labeling referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide and Rodenticide Act, as amended, is acceptable. A stamped copy is enclosed for your records.

At the next label printing, incorporate the following revisions:

1. In the Precautionary Statements, under the subheading "Hazards To Humans and Domestic Animals," remove the parenthesis from "and Domestic Animals."
2. Revise the statement of practical treatment to read:

STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT

If swallowed - Call a physician or Poison Control Center immediately. Gastric lavage is indicated if material was taken internally. DO NOT INDUCE VOMITING: Vomiting may cause aspiration pneumonia.

If inhaled - Remove victim to fresh air. Apply artificial respiration if indicated.

If on skin - Remove contaminated clothing and wash affected areas with soap and water.

If in eyes - Flush eyes with plenty of water. Get medical attention immediately.

3. The appropriate heading for the specific use directions should read:

"Subterranean Termites - Directions for **Outer Use**"

Since this product is subject to the child-resist (special) packaging regulations, submit a signed certification statement that the packaging complies with these requirements.

Refer to 46 CFR 162.16, "Pesticides Requiring Special Packaging," and the Federal Register, Vol. 46, No. 41, Tuesday, March 3, 1981, pp. 15184-15189, "Clarification of Policy Issues on Special Packaging," for guidance and proper submitting requirements.
