

Add a statement on the front panel referring to the location of the precautionary statements. The storage and disposal statements must appear at the beginning or end of the specific directions for use.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

APPLICATION SITE

M-GARD S540-O is only intended for use on exterior wood. Do not apply to food or feed contact surfaces. Do not contaminate drinking water with treated articles.

M-GARD S540-O Wood Preservative provides protection against moisture, rot and mildew on any natural wood surface. This copper naphthenate wood preservative and insecticide will preserve, protect and seal wood surfaces that will be in contact with soil, water or concrete.

The copper fungicide gives a green cast to M-GARD S540-O Wood Preservative. This product is not intended for use as a stain. The green color will fade within a few months when exposed to sunlight. Oil or alkyl stains or paints can be applied over M-GARD S540-O Preservative after overnight dry but the green may bleed through lighter colors. Do not over coat M-GARD S540-O Wood Preservative with latex paint or clear finishes until thoroughly cured (6 to 12 months).

PREPARATION

Wood should be clean, dry, and seasoned.

APPLICATION

M-GARD S540-O wood Preservative should be applied liberally by brush, roller, spray, total immersion or internal injection under pressure for the prevention and control of fungal decay organisms.

Dipping-Wood should be dipped for 3 to 30 minutes per inch of thickness. Fence posts, piles, poles, foundation timbers and heavy wooden members should be free of bark, dry, and well seasoned and immersed in the product for a period of 2 to 48 hours to be an effective wood preserver.

Internal Treatment-Internally treat previously treated utility poles or other foundation timbers. Apply M-GARD S540-O solution to internal cavity of wood structure through prepared openings using air or mechanical pressure pump. Apply one gallon per cubic foot.

Do not thin material as supplied at proper application consistency.

See one coat - minimum - on unfinished wood. Do not stain. If no stain is to be used, apply two liberal coats within the first 24 hours. Thoroughly cover ends. The more preservative absorbed by the wood, the longer and more effective the protection.

Clean painting equipment with mineral spirits for quick clean up.
