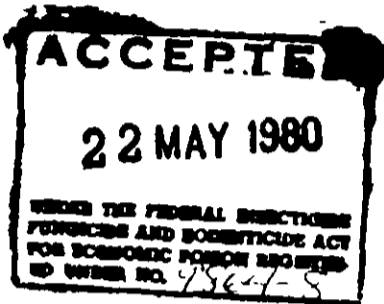

Directions for Use

GENERAL CLASSIFICATION

It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

Initial Application: To a cleaned pool add one gallon to 47,500 gallons of water, or ratio thereof.

Maintenance Dose: Use one quart per 47,500 gallons of water every 5 to 7 days. When weather is hot or bathing load is heavy, use this dosage every 5 days or as necessary.

Booster Dose: Immediately after every rain add one quart per 47,500 gallons of water as above.

Important: Follow above directions without fail, even when pool is not used. Algae growth must be fought at all times.
