The amendment referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide and Rodenticide Act, as amended, is acceptable provided you make the following changes to the label:

1. Under the "Directions for Use", separate directions for "Disinfecting". Revise the directions for use in toilet bowls as follows: "Remove or expel over the inner trap the residual bowl water prior to applying solution. Preclean prior to disinfection. Use 2 ounces of concentrate in toilet bowl. Squeeze around bowl and under rim. Brush thoroughly over exposed surfaces and under rim with cloth, mop, brush or sponge. Allow to stand 10 minutes, then flush.

2. In the third paragraph, under the "Directions for Use", delete ... and Disinfect".

A stamped copy of the label is enclosed for your records. Submit one (1) copy of the final printed label before this product is released for shipment.

**PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS

First Aid

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

This product is not to be used as a terminal sterilant/high level disinfectant on any surface or instrument that (1) is introduced directly into the human body, either into or in contact with the bloodstream or normally sterile areas of the body, or (2) contacts intact mucous membranes but which does not ordinarily penetrate the blood barrier or otherwise enter normally sterile areas of the body. This product may be used to pre-clean or decontaminate critical or semi-critical medical devices prior to sterilization or high level disinfection.

To Clean, Deodorize, and Disinfect Toilet Bowls: After flushing, force water over the trap with a swab or mop. Remove water from mop by pressing against side of bowl. Hold mop over bowl and apply 2 ounces of cleaner to it. Scrub bowl and flush ring. Rinse by flushing.

To Clean and Deodorize HIDDEN BOWL TRAPS: Pour cleaner into bowl and allow to remain several hours or overnight. This will dissolve incrustation. For best results in maintaining clean traps, repeat once a week.

To Clean and Deodorize HIDDEN URINAL TRAPS: After removing drain plate, place bowl mop in drain and pour 8 ounces of cleaner onto mop. Allow to remain a few minutes then work mop up and down until scale is removed. For best results in maintaining clean traps repeat once a week.

To Clean and Deodorize Ceramic Tile Floors and Walls: Dilute 1 part cleaner with 5 parts water. Apply and scrub lightly with a brush. If badly stained, allow to stand 5 to 10 minutes or use a stronger solution. Rinse thoroughly with clean water.

To Clean and Deodorize Tile Showers and swimming Pool Tile: Dilute 1 part cleaner with 5 parts water. Apply and allow to stand 5 to 10 minutes. Scrub stained areas with a brush. If badly stained, use a stronger solution. Rinse thoroughly with clear water.

To Clean and Deodorize Bathroom Sinks and Tubs: Spray cleaner over entire surface and allow to stand for several minutes. Rinse with clear water. Dry and polish fixture with a soft, clean cloth. Weekly maintenance of tiled areas and fixtures with a dilution of 1 part cleaner with 5 parts water will eliminate difficult cleaning operations.
