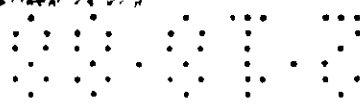

Also, in this same section, revise "... and before eating, to smoking" to read "... and before eating or smoking", and revise "Is not use on household pest or humans" to read "Do not use on household pets or humans".

- (d) Add "Contains xylene range aromatic solvent" under the ingredient statement appearing on the front panel.
 - (e) As indicated in PR Notice 87-3, you may either retain or delete "Do not plant any food or feed crop in rotation after a field treatment with lindane unless it is [a] registered use for lindane."
 - (f) In the "Insect Control for Livestock" section, after "Use a power sprayer to thoroughly treat animals." add "When spraying, use a sprayer capable of maintaining pressure of 200 to 400 pounds per square inch. Use 1 to 2 gallons per head for cattle and horses and proportionately less for smaller animals."
 - (g) Revise the heading "PREMISE SPRAY AND TREATMENTS" to read "LIVESTOCK PREMISE SPRAY AND TREATMENTS"
 - (h) In the "To Make A Paint" section of the livestock premise spray and treatments directions, replace the comma after "Do not use in the home" with a period. In this same section, revise "... or drinking ater" to "... or drinking water" in the last sentence of those directions.
 - (i) In the "Ticks and Chiggers", the use sites specified should be revised to "lawns and golf courses". The Lindane Registration Standard's Use Index inclusion of "camp sites and bivouac areas" under "Wide Area General Treatments" are for military use products.
3. Results of a one-year storage stability test for your specific formulation must be submitted to the Agency within fifteen (15) months from the date of this Notice of Registration. The formulated product must be analyzed for its active ingredient at time zero (initiation of the test) and during one year of storage at ambient temperatures (normal storage conditions in the container type to be marketed).
 4. Submit five (5) copies of your final printed labeling before you release the product for shipment. Refer to the A-79 Enclosure for a further description of final printed labeling and type size requirements for various label elements.

Soil applications: Do not make soil application to root crops, which might absorb a musty flavor. Do not apply in soil which will be planted to root crops (except potatoes) within 1 year. Do not use in soil which will be planted to potatoes within 2 years.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

PROTECTIVE CLOTHING REQUIRED

Applicators must wear water resistant hat, lightweight protective suit or coveralls, unlined waterproof gloves, (natural rubber, neoprene or polyethylene), and unlined lightweight boots. MSHA/OSHA approved respirators are required for applications in enclosed areas such as crawl spaces. Mixer/loaders must wear goggles or face shield, waterproof apron, and unlined waterproof gloves.

INSECT CONTROL FOR LIVESTOCK

Precautions - Do not use on Dairy Animals or poultry. Do not use on emaciated, overheated or sick animals. Do not spray animals within 30 days of slaughter. Do not treat animals under 3 months of age. For animals 3 to 6 months of age use a 0.03% solution by mixing 8 ounces in 40 gallons of water. Do not treat sows within 2 weeks of farrowing nor for at least 3 weeks thereafter. Avoid treating animals in cold stormy weather.

HORN FLIES on Beef Cattle

Mix 1 tablespoonful / 2 1/2 gallons of water (8 ounces per 40 gallons water.). Use a power sprayer to thoroughly treat animals. Treat when flies appear and repeat as needed for control.

LICE & TICKS on Beef Cattle, Horses, Sheep & Goats.

Mix 1 tablespoonful / 2 1/2 gallons of water (8 ounces per 40 gallons water.). Use a power sprayer to thoroughly treat animals. Treat when flies appear and repeat as needed for control.

SARCOPTIC MANGE MITE, LICE, TICKS on Hogs.

Mix 2 tablespoonfuls / 2 1/2 gallons of water (8 ounces per 20 gallons water.). Use a power sprayer to thoroughly treat animals. Do not apply to young animals. Repeat as needed for control.

SARCOPTIC MANGE on Beef Cattle

SARCOPTIC MANGE (SHEEP SCABIES) on Sheep and Goats

Mix 1 tablespoonful / 2 1/2 gallons of water (8 ounces per 40 gallons water.). Use a power sprayer to thoroughly treat animals. Use two or more treatments at 7 to 10 days intervals as needed for control. Observe good sanitation practices and spray pens and shelters to prevent reinfestation. Treat infested animals before adding to "Herd".

PREMISE SPRAY AND TREATMENTS

Precautions - Do not apply to Poultry Houses, Dairy Barns or Milkrooms.

FLIES, ROACHES, SPIDERS, ANTS & MOSQUITOES

In Livestock Pens, and Buildings - Spray with a 0.3% spray solution by mixing 4 tablespoonfuls per 1 gallon of water (8 ounces in 4 gallons water.)

Apply 1 gal on of spray mixture to cover 500 Sq.Ft. of surface. Spray to point of runoff. For crawling insects treat thoroughly cracks, crevices, baseboards and other hiding places. Remove animals before spraying. Do not contaminate milk or milking equipment, feed or drinking water. Repeat as needed for control.
