THIS MATERIAL, WHEN SPRAYED DIRECTLY ON INVADING CHEWING AND SUCKING INSECTS, WILL DESTROY THEM WITHIN MINUTES—PREVENTING FURTHER DAMAGE TO THE FRUIT OR VEGETABLE. PYRETHICIDE, A NATURAL INSECTICIDE, IS NON-RESIDUAL. THERE IS NO TIME RESTRICTION BETWEEN SPRAYING AND HARVESTING. SIMPLY WASH. HINS SHOULD ENJOY ANY TIME AFTER SPRAYING.

HOW TO APPLY: Simply dilute with water as directed and spray directly on the foliage of the fruit tree, vegetable plant, or ornamental hilling as many insects as possible. Spray the bottom as well as the top of the foliage, wherever the pests may be. Use a coarse driving spray rather than a fine mist. Remember this is a direct contact insecticide with no residual action. Therefore, only insects directly sprayed will be killed, any spray not striking an insect is wasted.

WHEN TO APPLY: Spraying should begin when the first insects appear. Do not wait until plants are heavily infested. PYRETHICIDE may be used any season of the year.

AMOUNT TO APPLY: Simply mix 1.2 fluid ounce (1 tablespoon) with one gallon of water and apply. Spray may be applied with hose-end applicators, hand pump pressure sprayer, watering can or trigger sprayer.

When using a quart size trigger sprayer, mix two capfuls (1/8 fluid ounce) with one quart of water.

Shake thoroughly and apply. Mix only enough for immediate use. Do not exceed the recommended rate, one-half fluid ounce per gallon of water is adequate.

Use a clean applicator to avoid contamination of the harvest. An applicator, reserved solely for the spraying of PYRETHICIDE, is strongly recommended.

INSECTS CONTROLLED: PYRETHICIDE kills the following insects: Aphids, Beetles, Caterpillars, Mites, Midges, Leaf footed bugs (squash bug), White Flies, and Leaf hoppers, Slugs, Cabbage Loopers, Leaf Tiers, Stink bugs and Currentworms.
