The labeling referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act, as amended, is acceptable, subject to the comments listed below.

- Correct the spelling of the chemical name for chlorpyrifos in the Ingredients Statement (ie. 0,0,diethyl).
- 2. Delete the colon which follows the signal word, Caution, on the front panel. The signal word should only be used to refer to the toxicity of the formulation, and not to bring attention to the fact that the contents are under pressure.
- 3. Revise the Physical and Chemical Hazards statement by deleting the words "caution" and "flammable." Caution is the signal word for the product and should only be used to identify the toxicity category of the product. Regarding the flammability of this formulation, your previous labeling has not identified it as flammable, and according to the Confidential Statement of Formula (dated December 1, 1987), the flash point of the product is 110'F and the flame extension is 18 inches. When this information is applied to section 156.10 of Title 40 of the Code of Federal Regulations, the product is not considered to be flammable. The rest of the text in the Physical and Chemical Hazards section is appropriate.

4. On the back panel, the last sentence of the Directions for Use, which begins "Do not apply this product in conduits..." should be moved to the Physical and Chemical Hazards section.

A stamped copy of the label is enclosed for your records. Five copies of the final printed labeling, incorporating the changes noted above, should be submitted for our files. Please submit this labeling within 60 days of the date of this letter.



Use as a spot or crack and crevice treatment to control cockroaches, waterbugs, silverfish, ticks, fleas and other insects listed below. Apply this product to localized areas where pests are found or may occur. Spray surfaces until wet.

SPOT TREATMENT: TO KILL ANTS, ROACHES, CRICKETS, SILVERFISH, SOWBUGS, SPIDERS AND EARWIGS: Spray into cracks, crevices, around baseboards,; and other places where these insects hide. Apply behind and beneath cabinets, refrigerators, sinks, stoves, and in and around waste containers. Contact directly as many insects as possible. For ants, spray trails and places where ants enter premises. Repeat as necessary for control.

TO KILL BROWN DOG TICKS AND FLEAS: Remove and destroy old bedding. Spray sleeping quarters of pets, around baseboards, windows and door frames, wall cracks, and local areas of floors. Repeat as necessary. Fresh bedding should be placed in animal quarters after spray has dried. Do not spray animals. Treat your pets with a registered flea and tick product to control the source of infestation.

TO KILL CARPET BEETLES AND DERMESTIDS: Spray along baseboards, edges of carpeting, under carpets and rugs, under furniture, in closets, on shelving, and in other places of harborage. Repeat as necessary.
