Dear Ms. Watson:

The labeling referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act, as amended, is acceptable subject to the comments listed below. Two (2) copies of the finished labeling must be submitted prior to releasing the product for shipment. A stamped copy of the label is enclosed for your records.

- 1. Replace the first paragraph under the Precautionary Statements as follows:
 - "Harmful if swallowed. Causes moderate eye irritation. Avoid contact with eyes or clothing. Avoid breathing spray mist. Wear goggles, face shield or safety glasses. Wash thoroughly with soap and water after handling and before eating, drinking, chewing gum, or using tobacco."
- 2. Move "Avoid contamination of food and feedstuffs." to the Directions for Use.
- 3. Under the Ingredient Statement replace "Inert Ingredients" with "Other Ingredients".


Since this product is for control of fire ants only we suggest you replace the 4. picture icon of a mite or spider with that of an ant (six legs). The ant icon on previously accepted label is appropriate.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE; It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

To kill Fire Ants in their Mounds: DO NOT DISTURB MOUDD PRIOR TO TREATMENT. Attach injector rod to can. While spraying, slowly drive rod into mound until resistance is met, which indicates the bottom of the nest has been reached. Spray for 5 seconds for each 6' diameter mound. For example, an 18' diameter mound would require three separate injections around the mound. All mounds in the vicinity should be treated. For best results treatment should be made in each morning or late evening when ants are least active.

PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS: HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC

CAUTION: Harmful if swallowed. Avoid breathing of spray mist. May cause eye irritation. Avoid contact with skin, eyes or clothing. Wash thoroughly with soap and water after handling. Avoid contamination of food and feedstuffs.

FIRST AID STATEMENTS: IF SWALLOWED: Call a poison control center or doctor immediately for treatment advice. Have person sip a glass of water if able to swallow. Do not induce vomiting unless told to do so by a poison control center or doctor. Do not give anything by mouth to an unconscious person. IF INHALED: Move person to fresh air. If person is not breathing, call 911 or an ambulance, then give arrifficial respiration, preferably mouth-to-mouth if possible. Call a poison control center or doctor for further treatment advice. IF IN EYES: Hold eye open and rinse slowly and gently with water for 15-20 minutes. Remove contact lenses, if present, after the first 5 minutes, then continue rinsing eye. Call a poison control center or doctor for treatment advice. IF ON SKIN OR CLOTHING: Take off contaminated clothing. Rinse skin immediately with plenty of water for 15-20 minutes. Call a poison control center or doctor for treatment advice. Have the product container or label with you when calling a poison control center or doctor, or going for treatment.

PHYSICAL OR CHEMICAL HAZARDS: Extremely flammable. Contents under pressure. Keep away from fire, sparks, and heated surfaces. Do not puncture or incinerate container. Exposure to temperatures above 130°F may cause bursting. ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS: Do not apply directly to water. Do not contaminate water when disposing of equipment washwaters.

STORAGE & DISPOSAL: STORAGE: Store in a cool, dry area away from heat or open flame. CONTAINER DISPOSAL: Do Not Puncture or Incinerate! IF EMPTY: Place in trash or offer for recycling if available. IF PARTLY FILLED: Call your local solid waste agency or 1-800-CLEANUP for disposal instructions.
