Dear Ms. Watson:

The labeling referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act, as amended, is acceptable subject to the comments listed below. Two (2) copies of the finished labeling must be submitted prior to releasing the product for shipment. A stamped copy of the label is enclosed for your records.

1. Replace the first paragraph under the Precautionary Statements as follows:  
  
"Harmful if swallowed. Causes moderate eye irritation. Avoid contact with eyes or clothing. Avoid breathing spray mist. Wear goggles, face shield or safety glasses. Wash thoroughly with soap and water after handling and before eating, drinking, chewing gum, or using tobacco."
2. Move "Avoid contamination of food and feedstuffs." to the Directions for Use.
3. Under the Ingredient Statement replace "Inert Ingredients" with "Other Ingredients".

4. Since this product is for control of fire ants only we suggest you replace the picture icon of a mite or spider with that of an ant (six legs). The ant icon on previously accepted label is appropriate.
