Hazards to Humans & Domestic Animals

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

Shake Before Using and at Frequent Intervals During Prolonged Use

Hold container upright with nozzle away from you. Press valve down and spray as directed. To avoid possible staining of fabrics or surfaces, do not spray at close range.

Restrictions

- When used as a surface spray, do not allow adults, children or pets to enter the treated area until sprays have dried.
- When used as a space spray:
 - Do not allow adults, children or pets to enter the treated area until vapors, mists and aerosols have dispersed and the treated area has been thoroughly ventilated;
 - o Do not apply this product in a way that will contact workers or other persons either directly or through drift;
 - Only protected handlers may be in the area during application; do not remain in treated area;
 - o Exit area immediately and remain outside the treated area until aerosols, vapors and/or mists have dispersed.
- For indoor uses:
 - Remove or cover exposed food and drinking water before application;
 - o Remove or cover dishes, utensils, food processing equipment and food preparation surfaces or wash them before use;
 - Remove pets and birds, and cover fish aquariums before spraying.

Flies, Flying Moths (Millers), Gnats, Mosquitoes and Wasps: Close all doors and windows and spray at the rate of 1 second per 1000 cubic feet. Direct spray to all parts of the room, especially windows and other light sources that attract these insects. Keep nozzle in constant motion. Keep room closed for 10 to 15 minutes after treatment.

Centipedes, Crickets, Roaches, Silverfish, Sowbugs, Spiders and Waterbugs: Spray into hiding places such as cracks and crevices behind sinks, cabinets, along baseboards and floors and around drains and plumbing, hitting insects with spray whenever possible.

Ants: Spray trails, nests and points of entry. Spray ants where possible.

Angoumois Grain Moths and Indian Meal Moths: Close doors and windows. Direct spray into all parts of room especially around stored food product containers, pallets and darkened areas. Spray 7 to 10 seconds for each 100 square feet of space. Keep area closed for 15 minutes following treatment.

Carpet Beetles: Spray directly on beetles, baseboards, floors, shelves and carpets.

Confused Flour Beetles, Grain Mites, Granary Weevils, Red Four Beetles, Rice Weevils and Saw-toothed Grain Beetles: Spray into cracks and crevices, around processing/handling equipment, cartons or containers and other areas where these insects tend to congregate. Spray 30 seconds for each 100 square feet of surface. Keep area closed for 45 minutes to 1 hour after treatment.

Lice: Spray on mattresses, furniture, floors, carpeting and inanimate surfaces. First spray an inconspicuous area to test for possible staining or discoloration; inspect after drying, then proceed to spray entire area to be treated. Hold can upright with nozzle away from you. Press button and spray surface to be treated from a distance of 10 inches. Spray each square foot for 3 seconds, directing spray into all infested surfaces until moist. **For mattresses, furniture and carpeting:** Direct spray into all folds, tucks, seams and crevices of infested areas until moist. Allow all treated surfaces to dry completely before use. Do not treat pillows, bedding or clothing. Remove linens and wash before reuse. Allow treated mattresses to thoroughly dry before remaking bed.

Bedbugs: Spray mattresses, particularly around tufts and seems. Take beds apart and spray into all joints. Treat baseboards, moldings and frames. Do not treat pillows, bedding or clothing. Remove linens and wash before reuse. Allow treated mattresses to thoroughly dry before remaking bed.

Fleas: Spray sleeping quarters, bedding, floor and floor covering where pets are kept. Do not spray pets. Repeat as necessary. Prior to allowing pets into treated area, treat pets with a flea control product registered for use on pets.

Storage and Disposal

Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage or disposal.
